Redeemed #51 – Sanctification Part 10

<u>10a – Progressive Sanctification: New Identity Mindset</u>

Rom. 8:12 So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. 13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

God as Father

Mark 14:35 And going a little farther, he fell on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. 36 And he said, "Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

Gal. 4:3 In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world. **4** But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, **5** to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive <u>adoption as sons</u>. **6** And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, <u>crying</u>, "Abba! <u>Father!"</u> **7** So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

Children & Heirs

Bearing Witness: The Spirit Helps us in Our New Identity

John 14:26 But the <u>Helper</u>, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he <u>will teach you</u> all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

John 15:26 "But when the <u>Helper</u> comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the <u>Spirit of truth</u>, who proceeds from the Father, <u>he will bear witness about me</u>.

John 16:8 And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment:

John 16:13 When the <u>Spirit of truth</u> comes, <u>he will guide you into all the truth</u>, for he will not speak on his own authority, but <u>whatever he hears he will speak</u>, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. **14** <u>He will glorify me</u>, for <u>he will take what is mine and declare it to you</u>.

Suffering: Part of our New Identity

Rom 8:17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, <u>provided we suffer</u> with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.


10b - Progressive Sanctification: Future Glory Mindset

Rom. 8:18 For <u>I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.</u>

Hope and Future Glory

Rom. 8:19 For the <u>creation waits</u> with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. **20** For the <u>creation was subjected to futility</u>, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope **21** that <u>the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption</u> and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

• Even creation is suffering because of sin



Our Doubts and Future Glory

Rom. 8:29 For those whom he <u>foreknew</u> he also <u>predestined</u> to be <u>conformed</u> to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. **30** And those whom he <u>predestined</u> he also <u>called</u>, and those whom he <u>called</u> he also <u>justified</u>, and those whom he <u>justified</u> he also <u>glorified</u>.

Rom. 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? 33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? 36 As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. 38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
