 - 2. God answered your question already a. not by special or extraordinary visions, visits or voices

b. but by the abundant marks of grace recorded in Scripture

3. One unmistakable mark is the earnest of Spirit: 2 Cor. 1:22; 5:5 a. Gift of HS is promised **upon faith**: Acts 2:38; Gal. 3:2; John 7:39

b. This 'gift of HS' is earnest of our inheritance: Eph. 1:13-14

C. How do I know I possess this Spirit as the *earnest* as fruit of Jesus' giving?
1. We know this by the fruit of Spirit's power – activity *within our soul*a. the test is not in our talk and religion (Matt 7:20-23)

b. the test is in our heart bend and wrestles (Col. 3:1; Phil. 3:20)

2. One caution in reviewing the unmistakable fingerprints of Holy Spirit
