Jerusalem Church: the mother church

Antioch Church: the first "model" church

Acts 13:1-3 brings the church into a very clear focus.

Backstory: Acts 11:19-30

Antioch--third largest city

Jew and Gentile believers

A great number **turned** to the Lord

Barnabas--sent by the **Jerusalem** church

Saul--brought by **Barnabas** from Tarsus

Instruction--taught a great many people

--first called Christians

Relief work--trip to Jerusalem
