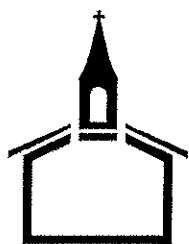

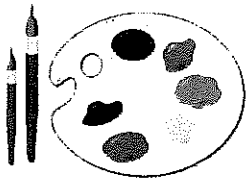
Fall Yard Sale
