Matthew 6:19-24 KJV

19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: (KJV)

19 "Do not store up riches for yourselves here on earth, where moths and rust destroy, and robbers break in and steal. (TEV)

20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: (KJV)

20 Instead, store up riches for yourselves in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and robbers cannot break in and steal. (TEV)

21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. (KJV)

INTRODUCTION

This Series focuses on living a life driven by vision of What God has called us to be. We need to learn how to Balance our life. The problem is that most of us have a tendency to work on our public lives and let our private lives slide. We work on how we look and how we smile and how we talk, but people don't see your private life, so you sometimes let that slide. These messages focus on what it takes to develop long distance vision, a life-long purpose to be pursued, as well as the ability to develop a strategy toward growth in the Christian Life. This vision for 2020 is about personal and spiritual growth that define your God given vision for the coming Year.

Some keys to remember about vision:

1. God's vision will **always extend you** beyond your ability and your comfort zone.
2. God's vision will **always require His provision.**
3. Never worry about **how**. If God gives you the vision, **He will** release provision. If it's a God-given dream, then He will intervene!
4. Your job is to:

1. **Believe** it – this opens the door to the possibility of it in your life.
2. **Receive** it in your heart – this is where you settle the issue in internally and you close the door to worry.
3. **Declare** it with your mouth – this will help you release your faith; speak faith-filled words and NEVER speak against the vision!
4. **Step out** in faith for it with your actions – faith without works is dead!

He's talking about seeing yourself — and your life — with the kind of clarity we have been talking about today. **Living with 2020 Vision means that we are able to see, with precision and accuracy, who we are and where we are.**

When **Ted Williams** was just a kid, he had a dream of being one of the all-time greats. He had a dream of making it to the Hall of Fame. But before his image could be enshrined in Cooperstown, he first had to perfect his swing. And before he could swing the bat, he had to see, with clarity, the next pitch that was coming his way. Lucky for him, he was born with perfect vision.

Our perfect vision comes through a process, led by the Holy Spirit. God has a plan for your life — a long-term, big picture vision for what he wants to accomplish through you. Before you can grasp this vision, you need to be able see — with accuracy and precision — who you are and where you are in this very moment.
