# The Blood of the Capital ' $L$ " Lamb

I. The $1^{\text {st }}$ day of the $7^{\text {th }}$ month: Offer 1 bullock- 1 ram— 7 lambs— 1 kid of the goats

Num 29:1 And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets ...
Num 29:2 And ye shall offer a burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; one young bullock, one ram, and seven lambs of the first year without blemish ...
Num 29:5 And one kid of the goats for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you:

## A. Besides the new moon offerings-And the daily offerings

Num 29:6 Beside the burnt offering of the month ... and the daily burnt offering ...

1. The new moon offerings: 2 bullocks- 1 ram- 7 lambs- 1 kid of the goats

Num 28:11 And in the beginnings of your months ye shall offer ... two young bullocks, and one ram, seven lambs of the first year without spot ...
Num 28:15 And one kid of the goats for a sin offering unto the LORD shall be offered, beside the continual burnt offering ...
2. The daily continual offering: 2 lambs (one in the morning-one in the evening)

Num 28:3 ... This is the offering made by fire which ye shall offer unto the LORD; two lambs of the first year without spot day by day, for a continual burnt offering.
Num 28:4 The one lamb shalt thou offer in the morning, and the other lamb shalt thou offer at even;
B. If the $1^{\text {st }}$ day of the $7^{\text {th }}$ month was on a Sabbath Day: 2 lambs

Num 28:9 And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot ...
Num 28:10 ... beside the continual burnt offering ...

## II. The $10^{\text {th }}$ day of the $7^{\text {th }}$ month: $\mathbf{1}$ bullock- 1 ram- 7 lambs- $\mathbf{1}$ kid of the goats

Num 29:7 And ye shall have on the tenth day of this seventh month an holy convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls: ye shall not do any work therein:
Num 29:8 But ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD for a sweet savour; one young bullock, one ram, and seven lambs of the first year ...
Num 29:11 One kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the sin offering of atonement, and the continual burnt offering ...

## A. The continual burnt offering: 2 lambs

## B. The possibility of the Sabbath Day offering: 2 lambs

## C. The sin offering of atonement (Day of Atonement): 1 bullock- 2 rams- 2 goats

Lev 16:3 Thus shall Aaron come into the holy place: with a young bullock for a sin offering, and a ram for a burnt offering ...
Lev 16:5 And he shall take of the congregation of the children of Israel two kids of the goats for a sin offering, and one ram for a burnt offering.

## III. $15^{\text {th }}$ day of the $7^{\text {th }}$ month—Feast of Tabernacles

Num 29:12 And on the fifteenth day of the seventh month ye shall have an holy convoca- tion; ye shall do no servile work, and ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days:
A. $1^{\text {st }}$ day of the feast ( $15^{\text {th }}$ day of month): $\mathbf{1 3}$ bullocks— $\mathbf{2}$ rams- 14 lambs— 1 kid

Num 29:13 And ye shall offer a burnt offering ... thirteen young bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year ...
Num 29:16 ... one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering...

## B. $2^{\text {nd }}$ day of the feast ( $16^{\text {th }}$ day of month): $\mathbf{1 2}$ bullocks- 2 rams— 14 lambs— 1 kid

Num 29:17 And on the second day ye shall offer twelve young bullocks, two rams, fourteen lambs of the first year without spot ...
Num 29:19 ... one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering...
C. $3^{\text {rd }}$ day of the feast ( $17^{\text {th }}$ day of month): 11 bullocks- 2 rams- 14 lambs- 1 kid

Num 29:20 And on the third day eleven bullocks, two rams, fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish ...
Num 29:22 And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering ...
D. $4^{\text {th }}$ day of the feast ( $18^{\text {th }}$ day of month): 10 bullocks— 2 rams— 14 lambs— 1 kid

Num 29:23 And on the fourth day ten bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish ...
Num 29:25 ... one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering...
E. $5^{\text {th }}$ day of the feast ( $19^{\text {th }}$ day of month): 9 bullocks— $\mathbf{2}$ rams— 14 lambs— 1 kid

Num 29:26 And on the fifth day nine bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without spot ...

Num 29:28 And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering ...

## F. $6^{\text {th }}$ day of the feast ( $20^{\text {th }}$ day of month): 8 bullocks- 2 rams- 14 lambs- 1 kid

Num 29:29 And on the sixth day eight bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:
Num 29:31 And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering ...

## G. $7^{\text {th }}$ day of the feast ( $\mathbf{2 1}^{\text {st }}$ day of month): $\mathbf{7}$ bullocks- $\mathbf{2}$ rams- $\mathbf{1 4}$ lambs- $\mathbf{1}$ kid

Num 29:32 And on the seventh day seven bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:
Num 29:34 And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering ...

## H. $8^{\text {th }}$ day of the feast ( $22^{\text {nd }}$ day of month): 1 bullock- 1 ram- 7 lambs- 1 goat

Num 29:35 On the eighth day ye shall have a solemn assembly: ye shall do no servile work therein:
Num 29:36 But ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: one bullock, one ram, seven lambs ...
Num 29:38 And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering ...

## I. Beside your vows-Freewill offerings-Peace offerings

Num 29:39 These things ye shall do unto the LORD in your set feasts, beside your vows, and your freewill offerings ... and for your peace offerings.
Num 29:40 And Moses told the children of Israel according to all that the LORD commanded Moses.
IV. Number of animals sacrificed each year in these 22 days of bloody worship

## V. None of this Old Testament animal blood ever washed away a single sin-Not one

Heb 10:1 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.
Heb 10:2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.
Heb 10:3 But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.
Heb 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

## VI. Sins are not removed by the blood of animals-But with Jesus' own blood

Heb 10:5 Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:
Heb 10:6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure.
Heb 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.
Heb 10:8 Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law;
Heb 10:9 Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.
Heb 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
Heb 10:11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:
Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;
Heb 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.
Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
Heb 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

1Pe 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things ...
1Pe 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish ...
Eph 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood ...
Act 20:28 $\ldots$ the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.
Rev 1:5 ...Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,
Rom 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved ...

## VII. The capital "L" Lamb of God (The Bible calls Jesus that 30 times )

Rev 5:1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
Rev 5:2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
Rev 5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
Rev 5:4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.
Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Rev 5:7 ... he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.
Rev 5:8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.
Rev 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
