## Righteousness Exalts a Nation Proverbs 14:34

## I. RIGHT: "righteousness exalts a nation" (v.34a)

- A. Blameless: "righteousness"
  - 1. Definition = justice, uprightness, what is right.
  - 2. Description = legal term; good outcome of a verdict; innocent cleared of all charges.
- **B. Blessing:** "exalts"
  - 1. Position = honors, lifts up to a higher plane.
  - 2. Prosperity = triumph, leads to victory over enemies.
- C. Belonging: "a nation"
  - 1. Definition = a country; the people of a territory united under a single government.
  - 2. Description = a group of people sharing economic life, distinctive culture, common language and border.

## II. WRONG: "sin is a disgrace to any people" (v.34b)

- A. Lawlessness: "but sin"
  - 1. Definition = missing the mark or path.
  - 2. Description = a lifestyle or act that deviates from that which God has marked out to follow.
- **B.** Liability: "is a disgrace"
  - 1. Position = reproach, shame, a very wicked thing.
  - 2. Punishment = diminishes, squanders, strips of success.
- C. Lawbreakers: "to any people" [see I.C. above]
