  - In Ezekiel 33:31-32 The Lord Tells Ezekiel:
    - That This Is How His Own People:
      - Would Respond To His Messages:
        - Of Truth!
    - "And they come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee as my people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they shew much love, but their heart goeth after their covetousness. / And, lo, thou art unto them as a very lovely song of one that hath a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear thy words, but they do them not!"

      - From The "Substance" Of God's Word!
  - We Must Also Be Careful:
    - To Avoid Reading It:
      - As Mere "Entertainment!"
        - Or As Just Another Book Or Story On Our Bookshelf!
  - We Need To Remember:
    - The Core Of Scripture!
      - Which Is:
        - Redemption Through Faith In:
          - The Person & Work Of The Lord Jesus Christ!
- \* From The Third Stanza Of This Conclusion Bunyan Wants Us To:

  - The Pilgrims Progress!
    - This Was The Genre In Which:
      - It Was Written!
    - This Means As We've Seen All Year That:
      - "All The Characters And Events Have Meaning!" (Ken Puls)
        - And That Is Why Bunyan Encourages Us:
          - To "Look Within My Veil!"
      - Because If You Do So:
        - You Will Be Rewarded With Things:
          - "Helpful To An Honest Mind!"
  - Now Even Though:
    - God's Word Is Not Altogether:
      - An Allegory:
        - There Are Many Different Ways:
          - That God Uses To Teach Us About Jesus Christ:
            - All Throughout The Scripture!
    - And So We See:
      - The Caliber Of Scripture!
        - Just Like It Took Us Time & Effort:
          - Just To Scratch The Surface:
            - Of The Pilgrims Progress!
      - We Must Take The Time:
        - And Make The Effort:
          - To Plumb The Depths Of:
            - The Riches That We Find In God's Word!

- It Requires Great Concentration: - To Get Beyond The "Milk" Of The Word: - To The "Meat!" - Even Though The Apostle Peter Encourages Us To: - "Desire The Sincere Milk Of The Word!" (1 Peter 2:2) The Book Of Hebrews: - Hebrews 5:14 Reminds Us That: - "Strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil!" - In Addition To: - Great Concentration - Also: - It Requires Great Contemplation! - Ken Puls Describes The Pilgrims Progress: - As "Endearing And Enjoyable! But His Substance Is Weighty!" - And - If This Can Be Said: - Of A Man's Book - What Can Be Said About: - God's Book? - The "Weightiest" Things In All The World: - Can Be Found In The Bible! - In 2 Peter 1:3 - Peter Tells Us That: - God Has "Given Unto Us All Things That Pertain Unto Life And Godliness, Through The Knowledge Of Him That Hath Called Us To Glory And Virtue!" - And That Knowledge: - Is Found In: - God's Word! - In John 6:68 - Peter Said To Jesus: - "Lord, To Whom Shall We Go? Thou Hast The Words Of Eternal Life!" - And Those Words: - Can Be Found In: - God's Word! - And So - What Bunyan Said About: - The Pilgrims Progress: - Is True In An Infinitely Greater Way: - "There, If Thou Seekest Them, Such Things To Find / As Will Be Helpful To An Honest Mind!" \* But Then - From The Forth Stanza - We See That Bunyan Wants Us To: Interpret Discriminately: - The Pilgrims Progress! - That Is: - Use Discernment: - When You Read About Christian: - And His Pilgrimage To: - The Celestial City! - Because - Like Noone Else: - John Bunyan Understood: - His Own Nature: - As A Saved, But Still Sinful: - Human Being! - So - He Says:
  - - "What Of My Dross Thou Findest There, Be Bold / To Throw Away, But Yet Preserve The Gold!"

- Is Truly Inspired!
  - 2 Timothy 3:16-17 Reminds Us That:
    - "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: / That the man of God may be perfect, throughly

furnished unto all good works!"

        - All True & All Truth!
  - So Only When Man's Words:
    - Reflect The Truth:
      - Of God's Word:
        - Is It Worth Listening To:
          - And Learning From!
  - And Further God's Word Alone:
- Is Truly Infallible!
  - Which Means What God Himself Tells Us About His Word:
    - In Isaiah 55:11 "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it!"
  - As Much As:
    - John Bunyan Wanted The Pilgrims Progress:
      - To Teach Both Believers & Unbelievers:
        - That Pathway To Life:
          - Was Through The "Strait Gate" & The "Narrow Way" Of Jesus Christ & The Gospel!
  - He Also Knew That He Had No Power:
    - To Transform Their Hearts & Lives!
      - Only God & His Spirit:
        - Through *His Own* Word:
          - Could Do Such A Thing!

- And That Is Why:
  - We Can Trust In:
    - The Certainty Of Scripture:
      - More Than Any Other Book!
