

# REVELATION 18 – PERGAMUM: BALAAM EFFECT



## UNDERSTANDING THE OLD TESTAMENT: BALAAM-BALAK-MIDIANITES

- Contrary to modern belief, Christianity is not a New Testament faith; its foundation is the Old Testament evidenced by Christ's letters to His churches
- Balaam {Not of the people}: Postdiluvian, Pre-Aaronic Priest as Melchizedek who emulated Christ's priesthood (Nu 22-24; He 5:5-10; 7:1-3)
  - Famous priest living in Upper Mesopotamia; priests accepted tithes for services
  - Balak {Devastator}, king of Moab {From Lot's 1st daughter} feared the Hebrews who
    defeated the Amorites {From Lot's 2nd daughter} who defeated him (Ge 19:30-38)
  - Balak, with Midianites {From Abraham's union with Keturah}, asked Balaam to curse the Hebrews for honors and money; eventually Balaam came but forced by God to utter three blessings; before he left, he earned his reward advising Balak how to weaken the Hebrews: Intermarry Moabite women to Hebrew men to destroy the Hebrew culture {Return to pre-Abram state Idolatry (Shin)} (Nu 25:1-9; De 23:3-6; Mic 6:5)


### ESSENCE OF BALAAM'S TEACHING: TRADING SOUL SEC FOR FLESH SEC

- Each person is Flesh-Body and Soul-Spirit (He 4:12)
- All born in sin {Lost}; reject knowing Christ, no Soul Sec {Guilt} (Ro 1:18-28; 3:10-18, 23)
  - Natural Man embraces Flesh Sec (ICo 2:12-14)
  - Natural Man <u>makes</u> own Soul Sec {Idolatry} to have Flesh Sec: Pragmatism {Ends-Means}
- Maturing Saved learn to choose Soul Sec over Flesh Sec emulating Christ; seeking city to come {Eternity} over Now World (He 1:8-12; 11:9-10)



### BALAAM: FALLEN PRIEST


- Balaam chose the World dying for his error: I st & 2<sup>nd</sup> (Nu 31:7-8; Mt 6:24-25; Re 20:11-15)
  - He chose Flesh over Soul Sec (Lk 8:36-37; 2Pe 2:14-21)
  - He pretended to believe but rejected God
  - His advice is Satan's major weapon
- But Melchizedek advised Abram to reject
   Flesh Sec for Soul Sec {Duality} (Ge 14:18-20)
  - Duality: Lot chose Flesh Sec, Sodom, while Abram chose Soul Sec, Mtns; reflected in Lot's daughters' incestuous actions (Ge 13)



### BALAAM EFFECT: ATTACK THE FAMILY-ATTACK GOSPEL

- Balaam's {Satan's} advised attacking Family destroying godly culture then the Gospel
  - Marriage merges Man-Woman into unity of Truth to produce the future: Progeny (Ge 2:23-24; Mt 19:3-8)
- Marriage reflects relationship of Christ-Believer {Church} (Ep 5:22-6:4)
  - Father serves, guides family via example by living God's Truth: Outward Perspective
  - Mother teaches and transmits culture: Inward Perspective (Pr 23:22-25)
- Moabite wives promote Baal worship to children; husbands subdued via sex-strife


Two-Prong Immorality: Spiritual – Divides from God Physical – Divides from Helpmate



#### BALAAM EFFECT: DESTROYING THE FAMILY

Maladaptive:
Increased Self-Esteem Illusion
Masks Increased Insecurity
Increases Violence


- Balaam's teaching changed families from interdependence {Good} to division {Sin}: {Jacob-Leah-Rachael} (Ge 29-30)
  - Division revealed first in Adam-Eve (Ge 3:9-12)
  - Husbands abrogate leadership or leave
  - Women build security on children to gain
     Control: Social-Moral Decline (Lk 12:51--53)
- God's truth rejected; no-gods substituted justifying Flesh Sec: Degradation-Violence



#### BALAAM EFFECT: EXAMPLE OF FLESH INSECURITY:

Maladaptive:
Increased Self-Esteem Illusion
Masks Increased Insecurity
Increases Violence

- Maslow's Need's Hierarchy scientism's delusion of Flesh Sec via Psychology
  - Ignores guilt-fear as product of sin: Fear of Judgment-Accountability (1Jo 4:18)
  - Freedom to be your own moral compass a lie: Psychopath {Fittest Survival} (Je 17:9-10)
  - Ends justifies means, Pragmatism, hallmark of Balaam's Teaching (De 12:8; Ju 17-18 (30-31); Pr 21:2)
- Promotes societal division-collapse; Satan institutes Socialism-Antichrist globalism to suppress Gospel and believers (Re 6:9-11; 12:7-12; 13)

### BALAAM EFFECT: NICOLAITAN'S PHILOSOPHY

- Balaam's methodology does not work in a vacuum; it is legitimized by worldly wisdom according to sin's elemental foundations (Ro 1:18-28; Ep 4:11-14; 6:12; Col 2:8; Re 19:15)
- Nicolaitan's Gnosticism, Neo-Platonism's One, later augmented by Aristotelian's Many, promoted liberal-social equality due to ongoing nation-church wars
  - Women deceived to believe their social changes bring good though they promote evil evidenced by disintegration of families, churches and nations: Remain guided by Men
- Balaam's and Nicolaitan's Teachings conflate Sin's evil for God's good: To make children of Hell and eliminate Gospel believers (Is 5:20-21; Mic 3:1-3; Mt 23:13-15, 29-35; Ro 3:8)
  - Modern social movements promote <u>same goal</u>: Globalism which Men control but Women are the face for *change* {Ecology; Fossil fuels; Climate change; Population control; Abortion; Critical Theories; CBDC; etc.}: Where this abounds, Satan dwells!

### BALAAM EFFECT: APPEARANCE OF WOMEN LEADERSHIP

- Balaam Effect clothed in Nicolaitan wisdom increases covetousness-fear-guilt and decreases security: Satan's Delusion His Throne (Col 3:5; 2Th 3:3-12)
- Women-infants leading families-nations; contrary to God's order (Is 3:12)
  - Example: Because Barak {Lightning} would not lead, Deborah led Hebrews against Sisera shaming men: Woman killed Sisera via trickery (Ju 4)
  - Women to be quiet in church learning, obeying their husbands as they are more easily deceived; Satan attacks them bypassing husband's guard: Eve (ICo 14:34-35; ITi 2:11-15)
  - Men not innocent; they actively <u>allow</u> women to be used for their own gain: Adam <u>not</u> deceived {*Plausible* Deniability}; Men remain in Control behind the scene (Ro 1:18-28)
- Satan uses women to make governments-homes-churches unstable increasing reliance on Satan: Jezebel; Whore of Babylon (IKi 21; ICo 3; Ga 5:19-21; Re 17)
