### A. The PROLOGUE of the Book of Revelation. (1:1-8)

1. The **TITLE** of this book is ... “The Revelation of \_\_\_\_\_”. (1:1a)
2. The **PURPOSE** of this book is "to \_\_\_\_\_ His servants \_\_\_\_\_ which \_\_\_\_\_ shortly take place. (1:1b)

<sup>19</sup> Write the things which you *have seen*, and the things which *are*, and the things which *will take place after this* .




### C. The PRESENT STATE of the 7 CHURCHES - Then and Now. (Revelation 2-3)

**D. The PROPHETIC FUTURE Which Will Certainly Come to Pass. (Revelation 4-22)**



1. There is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Church (1 Thess. 4:13ff; 2 Thess. 2:1 ff) so that we observe the Church in Heaven raptured, rewarded, and reigning with Christ in a great scene of worship. (Rev. 4). Why is this called the ‘blessed hope’(Titus 2:13)?
2. The Savior & Lord of the Heavens and Earth comes forward to claim the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Earth to redeem it for God because of His finished work & prophetic promises resulting in great honor and worship. (Rev. 5)
3. At the beginning of the Tribulation will be the 7 \_\_\_\_\_ judgments by God resulting in massive death & destruction, yet many will still not \_\_\_\_\_. (Rev. 6 &7) Does anyone get saved during this time?
4. These are followed by the 7 \_\_\_\_\_ judgments and even more death and destruction yet most still will not \_\_\_\_\_. (Rev. 8-10) How does John respond to all this?
5. During this time, the \_\_\_\_\_ will have been built and desecrated, the two \_\_\_\_\_ will preach, be killed, and then resurrected / raptured to Heaven, and a great earthquake occurs in Jerusalem. (11)
6. During the mid-point of the Tribulation, \_\_\_\_\_ is finally expelled from Heaven forever and seeks to devour / destroy the \_\_\_\_\_, though God protects a remnant. (12) Why does Satan do this?
7. Also, during the Tribulation, the \_\_\_\_\_ rises to world-wide power through utilizing religious deception, persecution, and economic control. (13) What is the mark of the Beast?
8. During the second half of the Tribulation, God pours out His wrath via the \_\_\_\_\_ judgments resulting in more massive death & destruction toward the unsaved earth dwellers. (14-16) What do we learn about death in this section?
9. During the bowl judgments, \_\_\_\_\_ is finally destroyed, with its spiritual & economic power, by God righteously avenging the blood of the prophets and saints. (17-18) Is God’s judgment just?
10. Finally, there is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lamb and the \_\_\_\_\_ (2<sup>nd</sup> coming) of Jesus Christ with the armies of Heaven to defeat the armies of the anti-Christ at the battle of \_\_\_\_\_. (19)
11. Next the \_\_\_\_\_ is inaugurated, with Jesus Christ ruling the Earth via a rod of iron in fulfillment of the OT \_\_\_\_\_ with Israel, and Satan being bound. (20) Does God keep His promises?
12. After a final satanic rebellion is put down, Satan and the demons are finally & forever judged in the \_\_\_\_\_, as are the unsaved at the \_\_\_\_\_ judgment. (20) Is this just & fair?
