III. HIDE GOD'S WORD (Psalm 119:11)

- A. The place to hide it is your heart, not your head (v11a).
 - "3 Let not mercy and truth forsake you; Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart.
 - 4 And so find favor and high esteem In the sight of God and man." Proverbs 3:3-4
 - "11 "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.
 - 15 But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience."

Luke 8:11,15

B. The purpose for hiding it is to overcome sin (v11b).

- "11 My foot has held fast to His steps; I have kept His way and not turned aside.

I. HONOR GOD'S WORD (Psalm 119:9b, 11a)

A. The Bible is divine.

"20 knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation,

21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit." II Peter 1:20-21

B. The Bible is truth.
