JOEY FAUST (1-4-23)

Jude 1:3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should **earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.**

4 For there are certain men **crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, **turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness**, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.**

Wantonness:

Isaiah 3:16 Moreover the LORD saith,
Because the daughters of Zion are
haughty, and walk with stretched forth
necks and **wanton** eyes, walking and
mincing as they go, and making a
tinkling with their feet:

"Wandering or roving in gaiety or sport; sportive; frolicsome; darting aside, or one way and the other...licentious...deviating from the rules of chastity; lewd; lustful; lascivious...Loose; unrestrained...not turned or formed with regularity..."

(Webster's, 1828)

**"v. To rove and ramble
without restraint, rule or
limit; to revel; to play
loosely."**

Jude 1:8 Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

2 Peter 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.

which are these; Adultery,

LASCIVIOUS, [ETC]:

Webster's, 1828:

...L. lascivus, from laxus, laxo, to relax, to loosen....

1. Loose; wanton; lewd; lustful; as lascivious men; lascivious desires; lascivious eyes.

2. Soft; wanton; luxurious.

"Tendency to excite lust, and promote irregular indulgences."

Etymology Online:

"...from Latin lascivia 'lewdness, playfulness, fun, frolicsomeness, jolity,' from lascivus 'lewd, playful, undesigned, frolicsome, wanton'...Meaning 'tending to excite lust' is from 1580s'..."

Oxford Dictionary:

"...sportive, in bad sense...Inclined to lust, lewd, wanton...Inciting to lust or wantonness...'How many are there...that...make no scruple to keep **lascivious** pictures to provoke themselves to lust?'...1660:... 'Their garments are something **lascivious**, for being cut and open, their skin is seen'..."

Westminster Larger Catechism:

"Q. 139. What are the sins forbidden in the seventh commandment?

A. The sins forbidden in the seventh commandment, besides the neglect of the duties required, are, adultery, fornication, rape, incest, sodomy, and all unnatural lusts...all corrupt or filthy communications, or listening thereunto; wanton looks, impudent or light behavior, immodest apparel; prohibiting of lawful, and dispensing with unlawful marriages...undue delay of marriage...

...having more wives or husbands than one at the same time; unjust divorce, or desertion; idleness, gluttony, drunkenness, unchaste company; **lascivious** songs, books, pictures, dancings, stage plays; and all other provocations to, or acts of uncleanness, either in ourselves or others."

Exodus 20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

Leviticus 26:1 Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.
