- Luke 1:32 "He will be called <u>the Son of the</u> <u>Most High God</u>"
- Luke 1:35 "He will be called the Son of God"
- Jesus is referred to as "<u>the Son of God</u>" over 40 times in the New Testament. This title is worthy of our attention.

## "The Son of God"

- 1. What it meant to the Romans and the Jews...
  - a. Romans: They had their "son of god."
    - Julius Caesar Caesar Augustus Nero Domitian
  - b. Jesus: They were looking for their "messiah."
    - Anointed one deliverer redeemer Savior King
- 2. What it doesn't mean...
  - <u>A</u> son of God
  - A biological offspring
  - A created being
  - Had a beginning
  - Second in rank
- 3. What it does mean... Jesus was\_
  - Scripture teaches it. John 1:1-3, 14, 18/Colossians 1:13-19; 2:9/Hebrews 1:8-12
  - Many believed it.
  - Jesus claimed it. John 5:18-29; 8:57-59; 10:27-38; 19:9/Matthew 26:63-65
  - The oppositions rejected it.
  - It speaks to nature, character, and identity.
- 4. What it means for us...

The deity of Jesus is a truth that is a key part of the belief that brings salvation.
