wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, 8 who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day

<sup>10</sup> I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that

divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same there be no
