- a. God's thoughts are not our thoughts—v. 8a
- b. Our ways are not God's ways!!-v.8b
- c. A comparison—Heavens are higher than the earth!
- d. So, God's ways higher than ours!
- e. God's thoughts higher than ours!
- 6. God's thoughts toward His People are filled with HOPE!
 - **→** JEREMIAH 29:11
 - a. To a discouraged people, carried as captives, God offers His thoughts.
 - b. God's thoughts include PEACE/WELL-BEING, NOT EVIL, TO GIVE FUTURE HOPE!

APPLICATIONS:

TEXT: Psalm 147:5 TITLE: "God is INFINITE!" (Series: Attributes of God)
→ Rearranging. Let's place all the attributes we have studied thus far under two large categories: "Attributes of G and Attributes of G" (Rolland McCune, A Systematic Theology of Biblical Christianity).
Notice then, two charts with this arrangement: Now, let's delve into a new attribute: INFINITY. God is INFINITE!!
1. WHAT IS MEANT BY "G IS I
A. Let's Understand the Word "Infinite"!
1. "In" = "a prefix meaning no, not, without, non-" (Webster's New World Dictionary, p. 708).
2. "Finite" = "having measurable or definable limits; not infinite" (<i>WNWD</i> , p. 524).

3. "Infinite" = "1. lacking limits or bounds; extending beyond measure or comprehension; without beginning or end; endless 2. Very great; vast immense" (WNWD, p. 721).

B. Let's Understand that <u>God</u> is Infinite!

- → QUOTE: "Infinity means that God is without outside limitations. That is, He is not restricted or bound by time and space ... He has only the self-imposed limits of His nature and will" (Rolland McCune, A Systematic Theology of Biblical Christianity, 1:214).
- → QUOTE: "He is actually Infinite Being (not a series) and cannot be added to in any way" (Norman Geisler, Systematic Theology, 2:125).
