10 And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in **Asia** heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

Miracles by Paul.

11 And God wrought **special** **miracles** by the hands of **Paul**.

12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick **handkerchiefs** or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

13 Then certain of the **vagabond** **Jews, exorcists**, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the **name** of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom **Paul preacheth**.

14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so.

15 And the evil spirit answered and said, **Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?**

16 And the **man** in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the **name** of the Lord Jesus was magnified.

18 And many that **believed** came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds.

19 Many of them also which used **curious arts** brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver. **market** for **curious arts**

20 So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed. **Because** **opposition**

21 After these things were ended, **Paul purposed** in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see **Rome**.

22 So he sent into Macedonia two of them that ministered unto him, **Timotheus** and **Erastus**; but he himself stayed in **Asia** for a season.

silver shrines for **Diana**, brought no small gain unto the craftsmen;

25 Whom he called together with the workmen of like occupation, and said, Sirs, ye know that by this "craft we have our **wealth**. \$ \$ \$

26 Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at **Ephesus**, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be **no gods**, which are made with hands:

27 So that not only this our **craft** is in danger to be set at nought; but also that the temple of the great goddess Diana should be despised, and her magnificence should be destroyed, whom all Asia and the world worshippeth. **Exaggeration**

28 And when they heard these sayings, they were full of wrath, and cried out, saying, Great is **Diana** of the Ephesians.

29 And the whole city was filled with confusion: and having caught **Gaius** and **Aristarchus**, men of Macedonia, Paul's companions in travel, they rushed with one accord into the **theatre**.

30 And when **Paul** would have entered in unto the people, the disciples suffered him not.

31 And certain of the chief of Asia, which were his **friends**, sent unto him, desiring him that he would not adventure himself into the theatre.

32 Some therefore cried one thing, and some another: for the assembly was confused; and the more part knew not wherefore they were come together. **Mob Protest**

33 And they drew **Alexander** out of the multitude, the **Jews** putting him forward. And Alexander beckoned with the hand, and would have made his defence unto the people.

34 But when they knew that he was a **Jew**, all with one voice about the space of two hours cried out, Great is **Diana** of the Ephesians.

35 And when the **townclerk** had appeased the people, he said, Ye men of **Ephesus**, what man is there that knoweth not how that the "city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the **image** which fell down from **Jupiter**?"

36 Seeing then that these things cannot be spoken against, ye ought to be quiet, and to do nothing rashly.

37 For ye have brought hither these men, which are "neither rob-
