Hebrews 13:1-7

Introduction: The church's love-hate relationship with good works

Context: Hebrews 13 reveals acceptable worship directed to others

I. *He philadelphia meneto* (v.1) – *Let brotherly love remain*

1. *Show hospitality to strangers* (v. 2)

An important Christian grace (Ro 12:13, 1 Pe 4:9, 1 Tim 3:2)
Great risk and Great reward

2. *Remember those who are in prison/mistreated* (v.3)
as if you were with them (1 Co 12:26)
