Exodus 30:17-21 Psalm 24:3-4 Hebrews 8:5(KJV)

Exodus 30:17-21 (KJV)

¹⁷ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, ¹⁸ Thou shalt also make a laver *of* brass, and his foot *also of* brass, to wash *withal*: and thou shalt put it between the tabernacle of the congregation and the altar, and thou shalt put water therein. ¹⁹ For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet thereat: ²⁰ When they go into the tabernacle of the congregation, they shall wash with water, that they die not; or when they come near to the altar to minister, to burn offering made by fire unto the LORD: ²¹ So they shall wash their hands and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, *even* to him and to his seed throughout their generations.

³ Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? ⁴ He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

Blue – signified the universal reign of His spirit. God is the possessor of Heaven & earth Gen. 14:19,22

Purple – signified the supreme royalty of God's spirit. "I am God almighty." Gen. 17:1

Scarlet – signified the perfect love of His spirit, I shed my blood for you. Ik.22:20

Linen- signified the purity and righteousness of His spirit.1 Jn. 3:3; Rev. 19:8



CONCLUSION

The incense on the altar was to burn continuously, symbolizing two significant things:

- ⇒ the unbroken intercession of Jesus Christ for us
- ⇒ the prayers and communion of God's people ascending to God

The second major piece of furniture in the courtyard of the Tabernacle was the bronze wash basin. The materials for the bronze basin came from the free-will offerings of the women (see Exodus 38:8. Made from polished bronze mirrors, the bronze wash basin played a very significant role in the priest's service to God. These are the facts:

- 1. The builder was to make the bronze basin with a bronze pedestal Exodus 30:18.
- 2. The bronze basin was to be placed between the Tabernacle and the Altar of Burnt Offering Exodus 30:18.
- 3. The sole purpose of the bronze wash basin was for the priests to wash their hands and feet Exodus 30:19.
- 4. The warning was stark and blunt: the priests must wash or die Exodus 30:21.
- 5. The importance of the washing and cleansing cannot be overstressed: it was made a permanent law for all generations Exodus 30:21.
