# Duality of Signs: Contrasting Purposes of <u>Night</u> Signs

<u>Great</u> Sign: White Lady Sign: <u>Great</u> Red Dragon

- $\rightarrow$  White Lady clothed with the Sun {Son} (Ro 13:11-14)
- → Crowned with Twelve Stars: Israel's Tribes (Ge 37:9-11)
- White Lady stands on, is, Moon-Israel {לְבָנָה} (Is 24:21-23; 30:26)
  - → Moon's Continual Cycle: New-Wax-Full-Wane
- $\rightarrow$  Reflected in Festivals
  - → New: Month; Year; Trumpets {Darkness}
  - → Full: Passover {Salvation}; Succoth {Light}

- $\rightarrow$  Great Red Dragon in the Sky is Satan (Ep 2:1-3; Re 12:9)
- → Seven Heads Crowns with Ten Horns
- → Πυρρός {Red} {Fire} Judgment Death (Re 20:11-15)
  - → Second Horse: Societal degradation and Death (Mt 5:21-26, 38-42; Jn 8:44; Re 6:3-4)
- → Darkness is Great Red Dragon's Sign (Mt 6:22-23)
  - → Present at Creation, challenged by Light (Ge 1:3-5)
  - → Wars against but cannot defeat Light (Jn 1:1-5, 9)

#### Ultimate Proxy War: Why Mankind?

- → Trinity is Creator and cannot be tempted by Satan's/Sin's weapons; i.e., Satan cannot **Be God** (Ja 1:13)
  - → Father is Spirit and must be worshipped in Truth and Spirit <u>only</u> (Jn 4:23-24)
  - → Jesus in the Flesh resisted Satan's temptations via the Spirit; Light overcame Darkness (Mt 3:16-4:11)
- → Angels are *spirit creations* of Christ to *serve* Father's development of *New Creation* people (Col 1:15-20; 2Co 5:17; He 1:14)
  - -> Angels not equal with Trinity and Man's destiny in Christ as adopted sons (He 1:5-7; 1Co 6:3; Ga 3:23-29; He 2:5-9)
  - → Satan *enticed* 1/3 angels probably with Hermetic Dialectic: Liberty, Equality, Fraternity {Rebellion} (Ec 1:9-11)
- → Man, made in the Flesh, object of Satan's Proxy War to attack the Father-Christ-Spirit to advert his judgment (Job 1:8-12; 2:4-6; 1Co 15:42-49)
  - -> Flesh easily beset, beguiled embracing self as god to sin (Ge 3:1-7; Ro 7:7-24; 1Co 1:28-29; He 12:1; Ja 4:1-4; 1Jo 2:15-16)

## Israel the Ultimate Proxy War: Birthing Messiah to Defeat Satan-Sin

- → Israel also a proxy war as *she* was chosen to *birth* the Anointed One {Messiah-Christ}
  - → Bethlehem chosen birthplace: House of Bread {Manna} (Mic 5:2-4; Jn 6:31-51)
  - → Messiah born of virgin; flesh provided by woman without father's inherent sin nature (Is 7:14; Mt 1:18-25; 2Co 5:21)
- → First Advent: Suffering Slave indicating God to die for Man rather than Man die for God (Is 53; Ro 8:3-4)
  - → Flesh **hates** humbling before anyone/thing (Ro 1:18-32; 8:5-8; Ga 5:19-21)
  - Struggle between True, guided by Christ, and False, driven by Satan, Jews {Jacob and Elijah} (Ge 32:242-30; 1Ki 19:9-13)
- → False Jews gained Kosmos Control(ish) via priesthood choosing Jesus as Passover Lamb (Mal 1:6-10; Mt 26:62-66)
  - → Their choice fulfilled Father's Plan bringing Salvation for all who believe (Ro 8:28-30; 1Co 2:6-10; Ep 1:3-14)

## Duality of Signs: Light over Darkness

#### <u>Great</u> Sign: Moon



- → White Lady-Moon. Product of creation
- → Relationship of Sun-Earth-Moon fixed by Christ
- → Moon has <u>no</u> intrinsic power; sun's/earth's gravity
- → Moon-Man dependent on Sun's energies
- → Moon-Man wax-wane in light; Son-sun is constant
- → New Creation has **no** darkness (Re 21:22-25)

- → Dragon product of creation; hence, finite
- → Dragon's existence does <u>not</u> fluctuate
- → Dragon appears as Light, Dark Light (Mt 6:22-23; 2Co 11:14)
- → Physical Darkness *seems* to overwhelm the night
- → Spiritual Darkness seems greater than light (Jn 1:1-5)
- → Darkness deludes Lost with Rebellion's Lie (2Th 2:3-12)

#### Final Thought on Dragon: Why the Heads?

- $\rightarrow$  Understanding the Dragon requires understanding meaning of the word {δράκων, drakōn}
  - → Derived from derkomai, look at, animal with bewitching, crippling look; thus, Eve mesmerized by the voice
  - → *Fire* metaphor may have sprung from his use of words to mesmerize resulting in sin and death; not actual fire
- → Evolution of Dragon's appearance
  - → Originally depicted with <u>one</u> head with no mention of crown or horn: No governments (Ge 3:1; Re 12:9)
  - → Government *begins* with Cain and reappears with Nimrod post Noah's Cataclysm (Ge 4:17; 10:8-10; 11:1-9)
  - Revelations' pertinent governments revealed by Christ via Nebuchadnezzar and Daniel (Da 2; 7)
  - → Heads, Horns and Crowns have biblical significance we will study in our next lesson to understand metaphor
