    - Where We Have Been Looking At:
      - The Very First Carols Of Christmas!
  - We Have Already Looked At:
    - And Learned From:
      - Two Songs That Were Sung:
        - In Anticipation Of The Birth Of Jesus!
    - The Song Of Mary His Mother:
      - Who Proclaimed:
        - "My Soul Doth Magnify The Lord!"
    - And The Song Of Zacharias The Father Of John The Baptist:
      - Who Sang:
        - "Blessed Be The Lord God Of Israel!"
- 2. This Morning:
  - We Are Going To Read:
    - Luke's Account Of The Christmas Story:
      - And Then Focus Our Attention On:
        - The First Of Two:
          - Songs That Were Sung In *Response* To The Birth Of Jesus!
  - The Song Of The Angels:
    - To The Shepherds Of Bethlehem!
      - Let's Read Together This Extraordinary Passage:
        - Luke 2:1-21!
- 3. What An Incredible Song Of Praise To The Lord All In One Verse!
  - 2:14 "Glory To God In The Highest, And On Earth Peace, Good-Will Toward Men!"
    - A True "Doxology!"
      - Let's Look At This Song More Closely Together!
- 1. The Setting Of The Angel's Song:
  - Immediately After The Account Of Jesus' Birth:
    - When A Single Angel Met A Group Of Shepherds Not Far From Bethlehem!
      - 2:8-12 Which Is A Setting Of Great Contrasts!
        - And I Believe What God Was Doing Here Is To Not Only *Tell* Us What The Birth Of Jesus Is All About:
          - But To  ${\it Show}$  The Shepherds And Us What The Birth Of Jesus Is All About!
    - **IE:** Just Like When I Was In Elementary School Every Month Or So A "Show & Tell" Something Special To You Well It Was Always Better To "Show" Than To "Tell!"
      - And So The Meeting Between:
        - The Angel Of The Lord & The Shepherds Is A Great Object Lesson Of The Gospel Itself! Just Think Of:
  - The Solitude:
    - Of The Shepherds!
      - 2:8 "And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night!"
        - A Group Of Shepherds Don't Know How Many But Under The Open Sky:
          - Doing Their Important But Often Thankless Task Of Keeping Sheep!
      - It Was Usually:
        - A Very Humble & Mundane:
          - Kind Of Work & Lifestyle!
            - And Often Very Lonely!
        - Their Profession Was Not Considered To Be Very Respectable:
          - And At Times I'm Sure The Solitude Could Have Been Unbearable!
      - But What Did God Do?
        - Into This Life Of Solitude:

- There Was:
- A Great Visitation!
  - 2:9 "And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them!"
    - It Was Sudden!
    - It Was Shocking!
    - But God Had A Message For Those Shepherds!
- But Isn't This A Picture:
  - Of What The Gospel The Good News Of Jesus Christ Is To Us?
    - God Himself Has Visited Us In Our Lives' Of Solitude!
      - Psalm 8:4 "What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?"
- God Is Not Just Telling Us:
  - But Showing Us That Jesus Came To Visit Us & To Bring Redemption To All Who Believe In Him!
    - But Also Think Of:
- The Darkness:
  - Of The Shepherds!
    - 2:8 The Were "Keeping Watch Over Their Flock By Night!"
      - What Kind Of Night Was It?
        - Not Entirely Sure But The Darkness Of The Night Then Would Have Been Different Than The Darkness Of The Night That We Experience Where We Live!
    - But What Did God Do?
      - Into This Night Of Darkness?
        - There Was:
  - A Great Light!
    - 2:9 "And the glory of the Lord shone round about them!"
      - Along With The Angel:
        - There Was A Sudden Display Of The Brightness Of God's Glory!
          - **IE:** Like The Flip Of A Switch To Turn On The Light In The Morning!
    - It Was Not The Light Of The Sun Or The Moon:
      - But The Manifestation Of God's Own Presence!
        - Like The Light That Moses Saw! Mount!
        - Like The Light That The Children Of Israel Saw!
          - Cloud By Day!
          - Pillar Of Fire By Night!
      - And It Was Something That Hadn't Been Seen In Israel For A Very Long Time!
        - It Was Sudden & Shocking!
  - But Isn't This Also A Picture:
    - Of What The Gospel Is To Us?
      - In Jesus God Himself Shined His Light Into Our Darkness!
    - John 1:4,5 "In him was life; and the life was the light of men. / And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not!"
  - This Is Also A Direct Fulfillment Of Prophecy:
    - Isaiah 9:2 "The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined!"
  - And So God Is Not Just Telling Us:
    - But Showing Us That Jesus Came To Bring His Light Into The Darkness Of Our Own Hearts & Lives!
      - But Also Think Of:
- The Fear:
  - Of The Shepherds!
    - How Would You Feel If You Just Saw:
      - An Angel & The Brightness Of God's Own Glory Turned On Like A Switch?
    - 2:9 "And they were sore afraid!"
      - They Experienced A Fear:
        - Like They Never Had Felt Before!
    - But What Did God Do?

- For Their Heart Of Fear?
  - He Gave Them A Message:
- Of Great Joy!
  - 2:10 "And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy!"
    - The Angel Did Not Just Tell The Shepherds To Not Be Afraid:
      - IE: Like We Often Tell Children!
    - He Also Gave Them A Reason!
      - A Reason To Calm & Reassure Their Hearts!
  - And In Stark Contrast To:
    - The Shepherd's "Great Fear" The Birth Of Christ Was A Message:
      - Of "Great Joy!"
- And Isn't This Why:
  - The Gospel Is Given To Us As Well?
    - To Turn Our Fear Into Faith:
      - And Our Sorrows Into Joy?
  - Even A "Joy Unspeakable And Full Of Glory!" (1 Peter 1:8)
- And So God Is Not Just Telling Us:
  - But Showing Us That Jesus Came To Bring Us Joy "Great Joy!"
    - But Also Think Of:
- The Number:
  - Of The Shepherds!
    - Not A Great Number:
      - They Would Not Have Made A Great Entourage For The Newborn Baby King!
        - But Even Though The Message Of The Angel The Message Of God:
          - Was Delivered To Just A Few!
  - It Was Destined For Many!
    - 2:10 "For, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people!"
      - The "Great Joy" Was To Spread:
        - Far And Wide!
    - Though To The Shepherds:
      - It Likely Seemed So Limited:
        - But It Would Be An Infectious Joy That Would Enter Into The Hearts Of Many!
- And This Setting:
  - Which Is Not Just A "Tell" But Also A "Show":
    - Displays To Us The Meaning:
      - Of Jesus Birth!
  - And Then The Angel:
    - Tells Them The Good News!
      - 2:11-12 "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. / And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger!"
    - The Savior That Was Promised By God:
      - From The Very Beginning When Adam & Eve First Sinned Had Finally Come!
  - And Just As He Finished:
    - It Was As If Another Light-Switch:
      - Was Suddenly Flipped On!
        - And 2:13 "And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying!"
    - A Large Number Of The Host Of Heaven:
      - Like A Band Of Soldiers:
        - Cheering For Their Commander!
          - And We Hear:
- 2. The Significance Of The Angel's Song:
  - 2:14 "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men!"
    - Different Versions Have This Translated A Bit Differently:
      - But It Has Been Best Preserved:
        - In This Simple Triad Of Praise!

- It Is A Three-Part Song From The Angels Of God!
  - And Their Words:
    - Are Not Wishes Hoping For These Things To Happen In The Future!
  - No Their Words:
    - Are A Proclamation Of What Has Happened In & Through The Birth Of Jesus Christ:
      - That Took Place That Night!
  - There Was At That Moment:
    - Glory In The Highest!
    - Peace Upon Earth!
    - And Goodwill In / Among Men!
- And So In This Song We Hear:
  - Words:
- Of The Greatest Praise!
  - "Glory" The Angels Sang!
    - Which Is An Expression Of Praise & Worship:
      - To God!
        - As A Response To His Glory & Goodness As Displayed In The Birth Of This Child!
  - Words Of The Greatest Praise:
- From The Greatest Place!
  - "In The Highest!"
    - It Was As If The Song Of The Angels:
      - That Were There On Earth:
        - Were Just A Small Part Of The Music That Resounded All The Way Up Into Heaven Itself!
          - Where All Of The Holy Angels Would Have Been Singing About The Glory Of God As Well!
  - It Was A Song Of The Greatest Praise From The Greatest Place:
- To The Greatest Person!
  - "To God!"
    - The Only One Deserving Of:
      - Praise & Worship!
    - The One Who "When the fulness of the time was come sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, / To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons!" (Galatians 4:4-5)
  - It Was A Song Of The Greatest Praise From The Greatest Place To The Greatest Person:
- About The Greatest Peace!
  - "And On Earth Peace!"
    - Remember This Is Not A Prayer Or A Wish:
      - But A Proclamation Of What Was Going On Right Then!
  - When Jesus Was Born:
    - "Peace" Had Come Upon Earth!
      - Not Merely As A Principle!
        - But In A Person!
    - Jesus Christ Is Himself:
      - The Peace That Had That Night:
        - Come Upon The Earth!
    - Remember:
      - Isaiah 9:6 "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace!"
    - And:
- Ephesians 2:14 "For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us!"
- And Just Like The Statement:
  - That I've Seen On A Church's Sign:
    - Only When You Know Jesus You Know Peace!
- And So The Angels' Song Was A Song Of The Greatest Praise From The Greatest Place To The Greatest Person About The Greatest Peace:
- For The Greatest Pleasure!

- "Goodwill Toward / Among Men!"
  - The Birth Of Jesus Was Done:
    - Not According To The Will & Pleasure:
      - Of Men!
    - But According To The Good-Will:
      - And Good-Pleasure Of God Himself!
- A Further Demonstration Of God's Own Grace:
  - To Undeserving Sinners Like Us!
    - Jesus Being Born In Humble Circumstances Is Not What Any Of Us Would Have Planned Or Expected!
- But Everything Was Exactly As God Desired & Planned:
  - And Through The Birth Of Jesus:
    - His "Good-Will" In Human Form Was, At That Perfect Time, Now Among Men!
      - He Was "Emmanuel" "God With Us!"
- And So The Angels' Song Was A Song Of The Greatest Praise From The Greatest Place To The Greatest Person About The Greatest Peace For The Greatest Pleasure!
  - The Pleasure Of God Himself!
    - What An Incredible Song Of Praise!

## **Conclusion:**

- 1. And Then 2:15 "And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven!"
  - It Seems As If The Angels Left:
    - A Bit More Deliberately & Slowly:
      - Compared To When They Arrived!
        - And Perhaps They Kept Singing Their Song All The Way Back Up To Heaven!
  - Don't Know For Sure!
    - But The Angels Gave The Not-So-Subtle Hint:
      - And 2:15 "The shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us!"
        - What Did They Do?
- 2. 2:16 "And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger!"
  - Exactly As The Angel Of The Lord Described!
    - Imagine What It Must Have Been Like:
      - For Those Shepherds!
        - With The Song Of The Angels Ringing In Their Ears The Whole Time!
  - There In That Manger:
    - Was God's Peace Come To Earth!
      - And God's Good-Will Among Men!
- 3. And I Believe:
  - That The Angels' Song:
    - Became Their Own Song!
      - Because In 2:20 "And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them!"
  - "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men!"
    - "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men!"
- 4. Is This Song Your Song:
  - This Morning?
    - It Will Be If We Are Like Mary:
      - In 2:19 "But Mary kept all these things, and pondered them in her heart!"
  - "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men!"
