## THE MIRACULOUS OIL AND THE FLOATING AXE HEAD

2 Kings 4:1-7; 6:1-7

- I. THE REDEMPTION OF THE WIDOW'S SONS (4:1-7)
  - A. The Problem: Family Debt
    - 1. The Debt of my Father—a picture of the human condition
      - a. Imperfect Parents—nobody, since Adam and Eve, had perfect parents.
        - Poor—unable to provide everything the family needed
        - Mortal—prone to physical or mental disability, won't live forever
      - **b.** Indebted Children—each generation inherits the debt of its parents
    - 2. The Hope of My Mother (Gen 3:15)—a son to care for her
      - a. Provide—home, food, clothing, etc...
      - **b.** Protect—physically, legally, socially...
    - 3. The Reality of God—His presence, power, love, mercy and grace
  - **B.** <u>The Miracle</u>: Multiplication of the Oil—God took *something ordinary* that this woman *already had* and *multiplied* it.
  - C. The Significance:
    - 1. God cares for widows and orphans.
    - 2. God cares for the family of a prophet (minister).
- II. THE RETURN OF THE BORROWED AXE HEAD (6:1-7)
  - A. <u>Problem</u>: <u>Loss of a Borrowed Item</u>—Iron tools very expensive and valuable
    - 1. Physical—iron sinks
    - 2. Legal—if you lose or somehow destroy what you borrowed, you must pay
    - 3. Financial—unable to afford a replacement,
    - 4. Social—don't want to be that guy that breaks or loses other peoples' tools!

- **B.** The Miracle: Iron Floats
- C. Significance
  - 1. God is sovereign over the Created Order. (Mat 14:33; Rom 8:38-39)
  - 2. God cares about our social and financial problems.
  - 3. God is willing to help us. (Jas 1:5) Even when the problem is our own fault.

## III. IMPLICATIONS

- A. Poverty
  - 1. It is not a sin or a shame to be poor.
  - 2. Being poor does not disqualify a person from spiritual gifting and ministry.
- **B.** <u>Debt</u> (Rom 13:8; 1 Tim 6:6)
  - 1. It is dangerous. (Pr 22:7)—Avoid it if possible
  - 2. It is binding. (Ps 37:21)—It must be paid
- **C.** <u>Jesus</u> (Lk 24:27)
  - 1. The Lord of Creation (Mat 14:33; Col 1:15-17)—The divine Son of God
  - 2. <u>The 2<sup>nd</sup> Adam</u> (1 Cor 15:22)—the One Man (Husband, Father) who *gets it right*!
  - 3. The Son of Eve (Gen 3:15; Isa 9:6)—the Messiah we have all been waiting for
