




Prophetic Search v.10-11

Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.




Profound Suffering v.10




A Partnered Self-denial v.12



The prophets were men who were called and chosen by God to do two things:

1. Proclaim God's salvation to man.

2. Prophesy and Predict how God was going to save man.

The PROPHETS spoke of:

- the birth of the Messiah,
- the character of the Messiah,
- the life of the Messiah,
- the sufferings of the Messiah,
- the death of the Messiah,
- the resurrection of the Messiah.
- They spoke of the life which the Messiah would give.


1 Peter 1:10 Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:


They "searched diligently" which is a phrase from the Greek word exereunao {ex-er-yoo-nah'-o}

which means "to search out anxiously and diligently."










Prophetic Search v.10-11

The Prophets wanted to know what the age would be like, the characteristics and signs of the time.

❖ They wanted to know the very same thing that the Lord's disciples wanted to know when they asked about the Lord's return: "When shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?" (Matthew 24:3).

They wanted to know the very same thing that believers want to know today when they discuss the Lord's return: When is Christ going to return and what are the signs of His return?

APPLICATION:

- What a challenge to us!
- If these great men of God had to search and search for the truth of God's Word and salvation, how much more do we?
- We are without excuse.
- We have the prophets as dynamic examples of men who hungered after God's salvation.


4. Salvation was to be wrought (shaped, formed) by the sufferings and glory of the Messiah (v.11).


The Holy Spirit, told the prophets that God was going to save man by doing two things.

1. God would send the Messiah into the world to die for man's transgressions; the Messiah would take the guilt of man's transgressions upon Himself and bear the judgment and punishment of man's guilt.

2. God would raise up the Messiah from the dead and exalt Him to the throne of God Himself.


Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

This word "Look" is from the Greek word parakupto {par-ak-oop'-to}. It means "to stoop down in order to look at something or to inspect with great curiosity."]




Gospel means good news and good tidings.

It is the glorious news that if we truly believe in Jesus Christ, then...

• <u>God counts</u> our faith as the righteousness of Jesus Christ. Therefore, we are able to stand before God as righteous, as acceptable to Him.

• <u>God counts</u> us as having already died in the death of Jesus Christ. Therefore, having died in Christ, we never have to die. We shall never taste or experience death. When we are ready to depart this world, in the blink of an eye God will transfer us into heaven and into His very presence.



- in ministering and serving


CONCLUSION:
