

- A. Dictionary definition of Heaven
 - 1. "The upper regions" A vast open area above the earth.
- B. The Bible divides this vast open area into three parts.
 - 1. The first place called heaven is found in Genesis 1:6-8.
 - a. We call this our atmosphere where God located the air we breathe.
 - b. Genesis 1:6-8 tells us this pocket of air divided the waters on the earth from the waters above the earth.
 Question: What happened to the water that was around the earth, above the atmosphere?
 Answer: It was made to collapse in the days of Noah causing the world-wide flood. Genesis 7:11, 12
 - 2. The second place called heaven is found in Genesis 1:14-19.
 - a. We call this outer space where God placed the sun, moon, stars.
 - 3. The third place called heaven is found in II Corinthians 12:2, where Paul says he was caught up to the third heaven.
- II. The third Heaven is a real place.
 - A. God's throne is there. Psalm 103:19
 - B. Angels gather there. Hebrews 12:22
 - C. There is a city there. Hebrews 12:22
 - D. Jesus is there. Mark 16:19
 - E. Stephen saw Jesus there. Acts 7:55
 - F. Hebrews 9:24 says Jesus is there.
- III. The third Heaven is located in the north.
 - A. Isaiah 14:12. 13 locates God's throne in the north.
 - B. The glory of God came to Ezekiel out of the north. Ezekiel 1:4
 - C. Psalm 75:6 indicates it's in the north.
 - D. Job 26:7 refers to an empty place in the north and modern powerful telescopes have now revealed such a place beyond the second heaven where there are no stars.
- IV. God's people go to the third Heaven when they die. II Corinthians 5:8

- V. God has arranged special transportation to get us to Heaven.
 - A. Before the rapture angels escort us there. Luke 16:22
 - 1. The trip is swift.

 Luke 23:43 "Today shalt thou be with me...."
 - B. At the rapture Jesus Himself will take us to Heaven. I Thess. 4:13-171. This is when God's people receive their resurrection bodies.

 - A. Jesus promised it. John 14:2
 - B. Jesus kept His promise. Hebrews 11:16
 - C. Abraham believed it. Hebrews 11:10
 - D. John saw it. Revelation 21:2
- VII. This city is described in Revelation.
 - A. It is big. Revelation 21:16
 - 1. It is 1500 miles wide, long and high. That's about Maine to Florida and Atlantic coast to Colorado.
 - B. It is beautiful. Revelation 21:17-21; 22:1, 2
- VIII. This city is an ideal place.
 - A. No night. Revelation 21:25; 22:5
 - B. No earthly trials. Rev. 21:4
 - C. No sin. Rev. 21:27
 - 1. Only forgiven sinners there. II Corinthians 6:9-11
 - D. Our departed Christian loved ones and friends will be there. Job. 19:25-27
 - E. People we have led to Jesus will be there. I Thessalonians 3:19
 - F. Satan will not be there. Revelation 20:10
 - G. Jesus will be there. John 14:3
- IX. I believe this Heavenly city will hover above the earth as God's satellite city during the Millennium. Revelation 21:2
- X. This Heavenly city will be eternal. Psalm 23:6
- XI. There are still vacancies available. Luke 14:23
 - A. All are welcome. John 10:9 "Softly and tenderly Jesus is calling you to come home."
