I was born in Ireland on February 11th, 1962. My parents immigrated to Australia in 1965. I grew up in south Australia. In 1979 I travelled on a working holiday with a dual passport to U.K. and Europe. On returning to Australia I took a job in the Northern Territory where I met and married Craig. Hayley was born in 1982 and Jenna in 1989. These were the 2 happiest days of my life.

During these years we worked hard and owned a Hotel and Roadhouse. The Roadhouse sent us bankrupt and long story short, led to Craig working overseas were money became his god. In 1992, on the 17th of June, I got saved. I started taking my girls to church, Sunday school and enrolled my girls into christian education. I believe both girls got saved at different times and ages.



Due to my own doing, in 2001, I stopped attending church, praying, reading my Bible and meeting with saved friends, as it was too convicting. I went full on back into the world and watched as my daughters did also. For this I've never forgiven myself. I was a very bad example of a mother. In this whole time I never stopped believing in God, not for one second. In 2016 my Dad was called home, it broke my heart

how he passed while I was in that state. I got myself right with

God and He restored the peace and forgiveness that only He can. After being told in July 2020 that I couldn't have a lung transplant, I decided meet with Liss and Luke, to prepare my funeral, to help my girls as much as I could, as I know they will be very sad.
