## A BETTER SACRIFICE

Hebrews 9:1-28; 10:1-4

- I. REDEMPTION THROUGH BLOOD—something has to die
  - A. The Significance of Blood (Gen 9:4; Lev 17:11, 14)—life is in the blood
    - 1. First Sacrifice in Eden (Gen 3:21)—to cover Adam and Eve's shame
    - 2. Abel's Blood (Gen 4:10)—cried out to God from the ground
    - 3. Capital Punishment after Flood (Gen 9:5-6)—reckoning for blood
    - **4. Jewish Kosher Regulations** (Lev 17:10-14)—do not strangle the animal or drink its blood
    - **5. Prohibition in the New Testament** (Acts 15:19-21, 28)—refrain from blood (citing Moses' being taught everywhere).
  - B. The Necessity of Blood ()—
    - 1. The Sealing of a Covenant (9:16-21)—The illustration of penalty
    - **2.** The Execution of a Will (9:15-17)—present the death certificate (show me the blood)
    - 3. The Price of Redemption (9:22)—The wages of sin is death
- II. <u>THE SYSTEM OF SACRIFICES</u> (9:6-10; 16-22)—"until the time of reformation"
  - A. Palliative (6, 10)—alleviating symptoms without addressing root cause
    - 1. Regular Schedule —continually recurring; continually dependent
    - 2. As Needed—for new injury or breakthrough pain
  - B. <u>Inadequate</u>—cannot end sin or restore the damage
    - **1. Cannot** Fix the Problem ()—the internal reality remains the same;

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- a. The Way is Shut (9:8)—only limited, provisional access to God
- **b.** The Heart is Sinful (9:9; Jer 17:9)—cannot perfect the conscience
- **2. Only <u>Cleans</u> the <u>Outside</u>** (9:10; Mat 23:25-28; Mk 7:18-23; Rom 14:17)
- 3. <u>Insufficient Value</u> (10:4; Mic 6:6-8)—Animal blood not worth human soul
- III. THE ULTIMATE SACRIFICE (11-15, 23-28)—His own blood is better
  - A. The Cost of Our Sin (Mat 26:39, 42)—real, terrible, registered in heaven
    - 1. A debt we could not pay—The cost of sin is our life.
    - 2. There was no other way—Jesus blood the only worthy sacrifice
  - **B.** The Worth of Christ's Blood (Gen 22:8, 14; Rom 8:3; 1 Pet 1:18-19)—only the blood of God can atone for the sins of the entire human race
    - 1. Suitable as Human (2:11, 14, 17)—the debt had to be paid in kind
    - 2. Qualified as Sinless (4:15; 7:26-28; 9:14)—true righteousness, no sin
    - **3.** <u>Capable</u> as Divine (1:3, 8; 9:28a; Isa 53:11-12)—to pay the debt of the human race
  - C. The Depth of Jesus' Love (Jn 3:16 and 15:13)—The Greatest Love Story
    - 1. He Committed.
    - 2. He Pursued.
    - 3. He Paid for Everything.
    - 4. He Gave Himself.
