Is. 64:6 We have all become like one who is unclean, and <u>all our righteous deeds are like a polluted</u> garment. We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Gal. 2:16 yet we know that a person <u>is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u>, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and <u>not by</u> <u>works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.</u>

2 - Good Works - Definition

Eph. 2:10 For we are his workmanship, <u>created in Christ Jesus for good works</u>, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Eph. 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, **5** even when we were dead in our trespasses, <u>made us alive together with Christ</u>—by grace you have been saved—**6** and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, **7** so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. **8** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, **9** not a result of works, so that no one may boast. **10** For we are his workmanship, <u>created in Christ Jesus for good works</u>, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

God's Workmanship

Eph 2:10 For we are his <u>workmanship</u>, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God <u>prepared</u> <u>beforehand</u>, that we should <u>walk in them</u>.

<u>3 – Good Works – Importance of Good Works</u>

Titus 3:8 The saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things, so that <u>those who have</u> <u>believed in God may be careful to devote themselves to good works</u>. These things are excellent and profitable for people.

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all people. **12** It trains us to reject godless ways and worldly desires and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, **13** as we wait for the happy fulfillment of our hope in the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ. **14** who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

Rev. 19:7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him glory, because the <u>wedding celebration of the Lamb</u> <u>has come</u>, and his bride has made herself ready. **8** <u>She was permitted to be dressed in bright, clean</u>, <u>fine linen</u>" (for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints).

Matt. 5:16 In the same way, <u>let your light shine before others</u>, so that they may <u>see your good works</u> and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

1Tim. 6:17 As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. **18** <u>They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share</u>, **19** thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.

Heb. 10:24 And let us consider how to <u>stir up one another to love and good works</u>, **25** not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Titus 2:7 Show yourself in all respects to <u>be a model of good works</u>, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity,

Titus 3:1 Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work,

2Cor. 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.

2Th. 3:13 As for you, brothers, <u>do not grow weary in doing good</u>.

2Tim. 2:21 Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful to the master of the house, ready for every good work.

<u>4 – Good Works – Faith without Good Works is Dead</u>

James 2:14 What good is it, my brothers, if someone says <u>he has faith but does not have works? Can</u> <u>that faith save him?</u> **15** If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, **16** and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, <u>what good is that?</u> **17** So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. **19** You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe—and shudder! **20** Do you want to be shown, you foolish person, that faith apart from works is useless?

21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up his son Isaac on the altar?

22 You see <u>that faith was active along with his works</u>, and <u>faith was completed by his works</u>; **23** and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God. **24** You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone.

25 And in the same way was not also Rahab the prostitute <u>justified by works</u> when she received the messengers and sent them out by another way? **26** For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, <u>so also faith apart from works is dead</u>.

Titus 1:16 <u>They profess to know God, but they deny him by their works</u>. They are detestable, disobedient, unfit for any good work.
