- 1. Read **Proverbs 5:21** and **Hebrews 4:12-13**. Why is Hebrews 4:13 important to keep in mind when attempting to catch the full impact and the intended effect of the truths found in Hebrews 4:12?
- 2. Read **2 Timothy 3:16–4:2** and **Galatians 6:7-9**. How would you explain to someone the importance of taking God's word seriously when it is read or preached?
- 3. Read **2 Timothy 4:3-4**. How can you make sure that you don't end up reading or listening to only the kinds of biblical teaching that you find "agreeable" or compatible with your present actions and habits?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 10:28-31**. How might you appeal and what might you say to someone you see blatantly and clearly refusing to respond to the truth of God's word regarding salvation or some other significant biblical matter?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 11:5-7**. If you were to testify to the benefits of a right response to God's truth, which he has graciously allowed you to experience, how would you describe its joy and blessing?
