## Notes for Further Study

- 1. Read the accounts of this story here in Mark as well as in Luke 18 and Matthew 19. From these accounts, we get an urgent, young, wealthy, influential man seeking out Jesus and asking that great question, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?"
  - a. Consider this man. Why might the disciples have considered him to be an ideal candidate for the Kingdom?
  - b. What did Jesus' focus on the word "good" intend to teach...
    - i. About Jesus?
    - ii. About the man?
  - c. Much of the teaching of the time suggested that wealth indicated someone was in God's good grace. Read Psalm 14. What is wrong with this theory?
  - d. Does it surprise you that Jesus began with whether or not the man obeyed the commandments? Read Deuteronomy 30:11-20. How could this passage be misinterpreted? What teaching by Jesus suggests there is more than just an outward obedience to the law that is required in order to gain life by obedience to the law? (Hint: try Matthew 5.)
  - e. What is it that Jesus is asking this man to do?
