²⁴ “A disciple is not above his¹ teacher, nor a slave above his lord.

²⁵ “*It is* sufficient for the disciple that he should become as his teacher, and the slave as his lord. If the *very* house-master ‘Beelzebul’ they nickname,² how much more those of His household!

²⁶ “Therefore, do not fear them. For nothing is concealed which will not be revealed, and hidden that will not be known.

²⁷ “What I say to you in the darkness, say in the light; and what

²⁸ “And do not fear because of those who kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul. But rather, fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in Gehenna.

²⁹ “Are not two sparrows sold for an assarion⁴? And yet one of them does not fall on the ground apart from your Father.

³⁰ “But even the hairs of your head are all counted!

³¹ “Therefore, do not fear; you matter more than many sparrows!”
