Context: In Jerusalem during the Passover (2:23a)

²³Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast,...

See 2:13 "The Passover of the Jews was near, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem."

Jesus had drove out those selling animals and the money changers.

Many Believed in His Name (2:23b)

²³...many believed in His name,

The Basis for Their Belief

observing His signs which He was doing.

Signs (see 2:11) are_"significant displays of power that point beyond themselves to the deeper realities that could be perceived through the eyes of faith." (D.A. Carson, Pillar Commentary on John, p. 175)
