Definite Atonement At-one-ment (middle English)

Covenant Terms: Sacrifice and Substitution

Major teaching: Leviticus and Hebrews

The sacrificial offering of Jesus made good all the Sacrifices offered in faith beforehand.

The O.T. believers' sins were transmitted forward to Jesus.

The N.T. believers' sins were backward to Jesus.

The atonement is an objective reality, not a potential possibility.

I assert to you that Jesus made atonement for **all**. i.e. All of the chosen people of all ages of all nations in all the world. And no others.

Hebrews 10:14 For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.
