The God in whom believers take refuge (1)

- He is your sovereign
- He is your dwelling place
- He is unchangingly the dwelling place for all of God's people

The reasons you ought to take refuge in God (2-6)

- Because He is eternal (2)
- Because He rules over the timing of your death (3)
- Take refuge in Him because He is very different than you (4-6)

The explanation of our transience, the existence of death, and the resulting need to take refuge in God (7-10)

- We are transient because of God's righteous anger (7)
- Against us as sinners (8)
- Which has resulted in the judgment of transience and death (9-10)

The right response to God's righteous wrath against us as sinners by those taking refuge in God (11-12)

- Respond by acknowledging your low view of God's righteous wrath and therefore lack of fear toward God (11)
- Respond by asking God to teach you about your mortality (12)
