What is worship?

- •To give or express the worth of someone or something with the mind and the emotions
- •God is always worthy of worship, in every place, in every situation, in every setting
- •Therefore, life is to be lived with a disposition of worship and honor to the living and true God
- •What we will talk about this morning is not to take away from this reality
- •What we are considering is in addition to constant personal worship
- The corporate nature of worship
- •By corporate is meant a gathering, group, or company of people
- •In the bible this worship gathering is described as small as 2 or 3 and up to a multitude no man can

number

What does the Bible have to say about corporate worship?

- •Old Testament references in Exodus, tabernacle, and then temple worship
- •These were not weekly for all, but occasional and centered in the city of Jerusalem
- •Emergence of inter-testamental synagogue worship during time of exile
- •A local and weekly place of education in the Scriptures and traditions of the Jewish people

from the Law

•This is the practice into which Jesus is born – Luke 4:16

•John 4:21-24 - A paradigm shifting statement that Jesus makes to the Samaritan woman

•That begins to be fulfilled on the day of Pentecost with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit -

Acts 2

•Afterward, a transition from Temple worship as well as overlapping times in homes

•Acts 2:42-47 - Essential parts of the gathered church community

•After scattering from Jerusalem, still a connection with synagogues for a time, then either rented halls,

homes, or river sides

•This seems to be out of necessity, not out of design

Assumption of gathered Christians in the NT epistles, especially Timothy/Titus

•Revelation 7:9, City of ch.21-22

What is New Covenant corporate worship?

Distinctions between Old Covenant/NC

•OC includes a special place geographically, a special building, priesthood, animal sacrifices,

incense, garments, utensils, etc.

•The book of Hebrews helpfully clarifies that many of these things were types and shadows, having

their ultimate fulfillment in the Lord Jesus Christ

•1 Peter 2:4-12 - A rich NC passage describing our privileges and worship

•When we gather, we do so as a people saved through the Gospel to offer worship to the Triune

God through the mediation of Jesus Christ in the presence and power of the Holy Spirit

•There is an emerging pattern in the NT of a change of the day of worship/sabbath from the 7th to the

1st day of the week

•Worship is:

•an act of loving honor, to give to God that of which He is worthy

•and act of loving hearing, to be personally transformed by the Word of God

Seeing what corporate worship is, how should we approach it?

More than a mere Bible study

More than a concert to sing inspiring songs

• More than a gathering of Christian people

•It is the personal-corporate engagement with the

living and Triune God, through Jesus, by the Spirit

- •How should we engage during?
- •Attentive, prayerful, careful -or- in and out, wandering, distracted, chatting, absent?
- •What should be the dominate attitude?
