

Redemption's family of New Testament words

1. apolutrosis - Luke 21:28; Romans 3:24, 8:23; I Cor. 1:30;
"redemption" Eph. 1:7, 1:14, 4:30; Col. 1:14; Heb. 9:15, 11:35
2. "ransom" (lutron) - Matt. 20:28; Mark 10:45
3. "ransom" (antilutron) - I Tim. 2:6
4. "to redeem" (lutroo) - Luke 24:21; Titus 2:14; I Peter 1:18
5. "redemption" (lutrosis) - Luke 1:68,2:38; Heb. 9:12
6. "purchase" (agorazo) - I Cor. 6:20, 7:23; II Peter 2:1
7. "purchase" (exagorazo) - Gal. 3:13, 4:5

Common aspects of these terms

1. Prior bondage presupposed (hopeless, helpless enslavement)
2. Payment given as the ground of release
3. Substitutionary nature of the payment
4. Emancipation of those for whom ransom was paid
