Human Power and God's Authority

Ecclesiastes 8:2-17

- I. A HUMAN KING (2-5a; Lk 20:25)—legitimate authority
 - A. His Authority is from God. (Rom 13:1-5; Heb 13:17)
 - 1. Respecting his authority enables him to do his job.
 - a. To protect from foreign enemies (Jud 2:18; 1 Sam 8:19)
 - **b.** To <u>administer justice</u> for his subjects (2 Chron 19:6-7; Neh 9:13; 1 Jn 3:4; Prov 28:28)
 - **c.** To <u>promote prosperity</u> in his realm, (2 Chron 14:7; Prov 11:10; Jer 10:21)
 - 2. Honoring his authority honors God.
 - **B.** <u>But he is *not* Jesus!</u> (Ps 78:72; Isa 42:8; 1 Chron 16:25 & 21:17; Rev 19:16; 1 Tim 6:15)
 - 1. His leadership is not perfect.
 - **a.** He is a sinner—his character is flawed—foolish, selfish, unjust
 - **b.** He <u>makes mistakes</u>—he is not all-wise or all-knowing.
 - **2.** He is not worthy of worship. (Isa 42:8; Dan 7:13-14; Act 5:29)—mindless obedience is not righteous or appropriate

II. THE WICKED FOOL

- A. <u>Hasty</u> (3; Pro 19:2; 1 Tim 5:22)—hot-headed, quick to join some ill-advised cause
- **B. Bully** (9b; Ps 76:7, 12; Isa 57:11-12)—not legitimate authority but human arrogance
- C. Hypocrite (10; Jn 5:44 & 12:43)—uses religion to manipulate for his own gain
- **D.** Enslaved (8b; Jn 8:34; Rom 6:16; Gen 4:7)—Given over to wickedness

III. THE WISE HEART

- **A.** <u>Law-Abiding</u> (2, 5, 6; 1 Jn 3:4; 2 Thes 2:3)—not lawless
- B. Patient (3, 6-7; Ps 25:9)—not rash, hot-headed, proud or immediately defiant
 - 1. Humble—not easily offended, angered
 - **2. Contemplative**—thinks before he acts
- C. <u>God-Fearing</u> (12)—gives us perspective we need to live wisely
- D. Radiant (1)—shining face
 - 1. The knowledge that makes you cry (1:18;)—the condition of the world
 - **2.** The wisdom that makes your face shine (8:1; Ps 97:9-12; Prov 9:10; Hab 3:16-18)—knowledge of God produces an underlying peace and joy

IV. THE BEST ADVICE (15-17)

- A. Enjoy Life—God's gift
 - 1. Eat and drink with joy (Ps 23:5)
 - **2.** Sleep like a Christian (Ps 3:5, 24-26 & 4:8)—don't lose sleep over things beyond your control.
- **B.** <u>Trust God</u> (Dt 33:27)—He's the One with the plan, He will judge...
 - 1. He understands.
 - 2. There is more than this life. (Prov 14:32).
 - **3. He is working.** (Rom 8:28; Rev 21:5)
