Jesus Christ begins the world-wide harvest.

. The Savior's Zeal and Delight in the	Work of Redemption vv. 27-3
(1) Much is Going On! -1- The beginning of a great work!	The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, 'Come, see a Man who told me all things I ever did. Could this be the Christ?
-2- The Samaritans about to flood to Christ	! "Then they went out of the city and came to Him
(2) The Disciples "Clueless"	"they marveled that He talked with a woman"
- Why is He talking with this woman?"	
 blinded by their prejudice: their view of the Samaritans their view of women 	
- blinded by their too little view of God's	redeeming purpose
- What's for lunch?	
(3) Our Lord's Deep Satisfaction in His R	edeeming Work
- Wonderfully "preoccupied"!	"I have food to eat of which you do not know
- His soul satisfied in doing the will of the F	ather "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work

(1) No waiting between sowing and harvest! (35-36)

-1- The 'norm' expressed in a well-known proverb

"Do you not say,

'There are still four months

and then comes the harvest'?"

- i.e., "We *just* sowed. Patience!"
"We've got a long way to go 'til harvest!"

-2- Look! The harvest is already here!

"Behold, I say to you,

lift up your eyes and look at the fields,

-"I just sowed, and we're about to reap!"

for they are already white for harvest!"

- Crowds of Samaritans were approaching across the fields!

-3- Sower and Reaper meet! And rejoice together!

- So it is when the Savior of the world has come!

(2) "You have entered into the 'Final Harvest'!" (37-38)

-1- A proverb that in this case does apply!

"For in this the saying is true:
'One sows and another reaps.'"

-2-"Yours is the privilege of reaping in the 'super-harvest'!"

- All of the promises of God to redeem are now coming into their own
- All that the prophets had foretold in this regard; all for which they had waited!
