(2-18-24) THE SUPERBOWL AD AND THE 1000 YEARS!

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TEXT: 2 Samuel 6:1 Again, David gathered together all the chosen men of Israel, thirty thousand.

- 2 And David arose, and went with all the people that were with him from Baale of Judah, to bring up from thence the ark of God...
- 3 And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that was in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.
- **Malachi 1:8** And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

- <u>6 And when they came to Nachon's threshingfloor, Uzzah put forth his hand to the</u> ark of God, and took hold of it; for the oxen shook it.
- Matthew 16:21 From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.
- 22 Then Peter took him, and **began to rebuke him**, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee.

"...a new cart was used through respect, as that had never been applied to any profane or common purpose. But this was not sufficient, for the ark should have been carried on the shoulders of the priests..." (Clarke)

1 Chronicles 15:11 And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites...

12 And said unto them, Ye are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both ye and your brethren, that ye may bring up the ark of the LORD God of Israel unto the place that I have prepared for it.

13 For because ye did it not at the first, the LORD our God made a breach upon us, for that we sought him not after the due order.

"During Super Bowl Sunday, a 60-second ad aired about Jesus Christ, and no one seemed angrier about it than Christians...An oil rig worker washes the feet of a climate activist. A cop washes the feet of a young Black man. An older woman washes the feet of a young woman outside an apparent abortion clinic while abortion protesters look on. A priest washes the feet of a young gay man. As the commercial ends, words appear on the screen: 'Jesus didn't teach hate. He washed feet.'

The ad came from a group called *He Gets Us*, which is running a multimillion-dollar ad campaign with **the aim of essentially reintroducing America to Jesus**. Its website asks, 'How did the story of a man who taught and practiced unconditional love **become associated with hatred and oppression** for

so many people?'...The most radically right-wing Christians were furious at the ad, and they've stayed furious for days..."
