Sermon: Yes, God Destroys People. "The Faithful Outcasts" Pt.9

I Text:

Old Covenant: Numbers 14;1-11 New Covenant: Hebrews 3:12-18

II Doctrine:

The terrible God of the covenant will destroy those who rebel against him. We are to persevere until the end of our walk with God on this planet. Our relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ is dynamic and he is faithful to preserve us. The seeming paradox of God's sovereignty and man's responsibility pervades all of scripture.

God demands Covenant faithfulness from his people. Our walk will never be perfect as God's people, but our way of life must honor our Father in heaven. Open rebellion against the Torah of Christ and his people will lead to destruction. God will destroy all unrepentant rebels in his midst. This is what we are now witnessing in the Western church especially.

III Comparing Scripture With Scripture:

- 1) The terrible God of the covenant will destroy those who rebel against him. We are to persevere until the end of our walk with God on this planet.
