# I. The Clear <u>Command</u>

Job 31:29-30 "If I rejoiced at the destruction of him that hated me, or lifted up myself when evil found him:  $\frac{30}{10}$  Neither have I suffered my mouth to sin by wishing a curse to his soul."

Job 31:31-32 "If the men of my tabernacle said not, Oh that we had of his flesh! we cannot be satisfied.  $\frac{32}{2}$  The stranger did not lodge in the street: *but* I opened my doors to the traveler."

Job 1:1 "There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name *was* Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil."

Psalm 35:12-15 "They rewarded me evil for good *to* the spoiling of my soul. <sup>13</sup> But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing *was* sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom. <sup>14</sup> I behaved myself as though *he had been* my friend *or* brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth *for his* mother. <sup>15</sup> But in mine adversity they rejoiced, and gathered themselves together: *yea*, the abjects gathered themselves together against me, and I knew *it* not; they did tear *me*, and ceased not:"
