RECEIVE

- Read the passage and listen to Sunday's sermon (if you have not done so already).
- Ask God to help you understand and respond to the passage in faith.
- □ Reread the passage, taking note of any words or phrases that stand out.

REFLECT

- In verse 2 Paul tells us to "walk in love", using Jesus as the model for this. Write down a few things that come to mind when we think of Jesus's love.
- Verses 3-5 Paul lists some the behaviours we are to avoid. What behaviours can we deduce from this list that we should we then pursue as the children of God?
- How does verse 8 impact your confidence in Christ and by extension your walk in Him?
- What does it mean to "reprove" (expose) the works of darkness in verse 11, and how can we do this?
- In verse 15 we are told to walk wisely. Mediate upon this truth in relation to your own walk, and the decisions you have made recently, or have coming up.
- □ Verse 16 speaks into our time management. How are you managing your time?

RESPOND

- How will you apply any gospel encouragement from your reading and reflection for the day and week ahead?
- □ What areas of your life have you identified that need to have gospel truth applied, in order for you to receive grace and peace from God?
- Spend some time in prayer with the Lord about the things He has revealed to you in this passage.
- Ask God to help you respond in faith to His word.
- Commit to applying whatever gospel encouragement or challenge you have received into practice.
