2A I have a new identity because I have been baptized in Christ, v27

- **1B** I have been baptized into Christ's death.
- **2B** I have been baptized into Christ's resurrection.

3A I have a new identity because I am one in Christ with others, v28

- **1B** I have union with Christ because of the indwelling Spirit of God.
- **2B** I have union with others in Christ because we all are indwelt by the same Spirit.

4A I have a new identity because I belong to Christ and am a co-heir with Him, v29

- **1B** I have been given to Christ by the Father and can't be un-given.
- **2B** I have been given an inheritance in Christ by the Father which can't be un-given.
