- Section 1: A Nature Of True Righteousness Has Been Displayed, (Chpt. 3 – 4)
 6. Obedience that confronts the reality of sin & brings the healing of the gospel, (vs. 23 – 25)
 - a. The gospel ministers to the sinner holistically, not partially, (vs. 23)
 - The gospel instructs all people as to the truth of God, (vs. 23a); *"and coming to his hometown he taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these mighty works?" (Matthew 13:54)*
 - The gospel proclaims to all people the reality of God, (vs. 23b); *"but he said to them, "I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns as well; for I was sent for this purpose." (Luke 4:43)*
 - The gospel brings healing as validation of God, (vs. 23c); *"Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who FORGIVES all your iniquity, who HEALS all your diseases, who REDEEMS your life from the pit, who CROWNS you with steadfast love and mercy, who SATISFIES you with good so that your youth is RENEWED like the eagle's." (Psalm 103:2-5)*
 - b. The gospel ministers to the sinner on every level of life, not just circumstantially, (vs. 24)
 - The message of the gospel will spread, (vs. 24a); *"Now to him who is ABLE TO STRENGTHEN you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept SECRET for long ages but has now been DISCLOSED and through the prophetic writings has been made KNOWN to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith— to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen. " (Romans 16:25-27)*
 - The message of the gospel has power over the natural & the supernatural, (vs. 24b); *"And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved" (Ephesians 2:1-5)*
 - The message of the gospel has power over the chronic & the acute, (vs. 24c); *"As he passed by, he saw a man blind from birth. And his disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" Jesus answered, "It was not that this man sinned, or his parents, but that the works of God might be displayed in him." (John 9:1-3)*
 - The message of the gospel has power over the spiritually ill, (vs. 24d); *"And in the synagogue there was a man who had the spirit of an unclean demon, and he cried out with a loud voice, "Ha! What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are— the Holy One of God." But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be silent and come out of him!" And when the demon had thrown him down in their midst, he came out of him, having done him no harm. " (Luke 4:33-35)*
 - The message of the gospel has power over the mentally ill, (vs. 24e); *"said, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly. For often he falls into the fire, and often into the water. " (Matthew 17:15)*
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 - c. The gospel ministers to the sinner regardless of who they are, (vs. 25)
