INTRODUCTION: DECEPTION & VALENTINE'S DAY?!

POINT: ALWAYS TELL THE TRUTH *WISELY* (Ex.20:16; Eph.4:24; Col.3:9; Mt.10:16;

see Conduct, Murray, c.6; see Divorce, Murray; see 1Cor.6:1f; 1Tm.5:17)

I. CLEAR

- **A. GOD IS TRUE** (Rom.3:4; see Jms.1:17)
 - 1. His word is truth (Jn.17:17; see Jms.1:18)
 - 2. His image is truth (Eph.4:24; 5:9; Col.3:9; Ex.20:16(Gen.2,3); see Eccl.7:29a)
 - 3. Conclusion: man was created to speak truth (Eccl.7:29a; Eph.4:15,25)
- B. SATAN IS FALSE (Jn.8:44; Gen.3:1f)
 - 1. His word is falsehood (Jn.8:44; Gen.3:1f,13; Mt.4:1f)
 - 2. His image is falsehood (Jn.8:44; 1Jn.3:8; Rev.22:15; see Gen.3:13f;)
 - 3. Conclusion: man has fallen into being deceived and deceiving (Eccl.7:29; see 2Tm.3:13)

II. CLOUDY

- A. SIN RUINS ALL; GOOD ANSWERS GONE (see Rom.6:23; Gen.2:17; 3:14f)
- **B. APPARENT CONTRADICTIONS** (note: war vs. everyday life)
 - 1. Rahab: praised for ends, not means (Josh.2:1f; Heb.11:31; Jms.2:25)
 - 2. Joshua: truth without explanation (Josh.8:3-29; see Dan.2:4)
 - 3. Samuel: truth without context (1Sam.16:1-5; see Dt.29:29)
- **C. GOD IS ASTUTE** (Ps.18:26; Job 5:13(=1Cor.3:19); Acts 5:1f(Eph.5:11); see Eccl.3:1f)
- D. GOD IS JUST
 - 1. equity (Ps.18:26; Job 5:13; Rom.1:24,25,29; 2Th.2:10,11; 2Tm.3:13)
 - 2. judgment (Ps.7:14-16; 9:15,16; 10:2; Prv.26:27)
 - 3. sovereignty (1Kngs.22:1f,20f; 2Tm.4:3,4(3:13); see Jms.1:13-16; deceived)

III. CLARIFIED

- A. INOCULATE YOURSELF AGAINST DECEPTION! (2Th.2:10-13; Eph.4:11-14; Heb.5:14; Jn.8:32; 17:17)
- **B. DO NOT DECEIVE SO THAT YOU WILL NOT BE DECEIVED!** (Ps.18:26; Job 5:13; 2Tm.3:13; Ps.7:14-16; 9:15,16; 10:2; Prv.26:27)
- C CDT () CDT ()
- *C. SPEAK TRUTH* <u>TRULY!</u> (Jer.9:5; Zech.8:16; Eph.4:25; see Jn.8:45f; 16:13)

1. Speak the truth <u>in love</u> (Eph.4:15,25,29; see 1Jn.2:4f; 4:20f /see LC,143-145)

2. Love God and your neighbor (Mt.22:37f)

3. not false witness <u>against your neighbor</u> (Ex.20:16; see Eph.4:25)

4. Innocent as dove <u>wise as serpent</u> (Mt.10:2)

- D. WHEN TEMPTED TO LIE, BE INNOCENT DOVE AND WISE SERPENT! (Mt.10:16; note: persecution)
 - 1. dove: find something true to say (1Sam.16:1-3; see Eph.4:25; Col.3:9)
 - 2. dove: submit to full disclosure under lawful oath (Prv25:2; 1Kngs8:31; Ex22:7f; eg, Josh7:19; Jn9:24; Mt26:63 /see WCF 22,2)
 - 3. serpent: say as little as possible (Prov.17:28; see Dt.29:29)
 - 4. serpent: do not elaborate or interpret where possible (see Josh.8:3f,6)

POINT: ALWAYS TELL THE TRUTH WISELY (Ex.20:16; Eph.4:24; Col.3:9; Mt.10:16;

see Conduct, Murray, c.6; see Divorce, Murray; see 1Cor.6:1f; 1Tm.5:17)
