- 4. Since Luke assigns fault to neither Paul nor Barnabas, we should consider that finding fault is not his main point. What then is his stated point?
- 5. What works against God using the disagreements you face with other Christians?
- 6. How must you manage your disagreements in order to live out the reality of what God has done for you in Christ?
- 7. Before God, will you?
