## Chapter 56, Think Position - Pg 253-256

## Intro: Pr 23:7

- I. The Two Parts of our Position In Christ
  - A. Identification with His Death, His Life and Resurrection
    - 1. God's Eternal Purposes
      - a. Salvation is not about our benefit Heaven.
      - b. Salvation is about God's Glory Ac 2:23; Ro 8:28; 9:11; 1 Jo 3:8; Rev 17:16-17
    - 2. Christ's Life, Death, Resurrection Gloried God and makes it possible for Us to be able to Glorify God.
      - a. His life always pleased the Father Mt 3:17; 12:18; 17:5; 2Pe 1:17
      - b. His death satisfied God's wrath turning it from us so that we might be reconciled to Him – Ro 3:25; Heb 2:17; 1 Jo 2:2; 4:10; Ro 5:10; 2 Co 5:18; Col 1:21
      - c. His resurrection justifies (declares us righteous) the believer before God creating us as new creatures that we might live unto God Ro 3:24; 4:5,25; 5:9; 8:30,33; Tit 3:7
  - B. Position Above Our identification with His Exaltation
    - 1. His Position The Right Hand of God's throne Eph 1:20; Heb 8:1
    - 2. Our Position
      - a. Blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, Eph 1:3
      - B. Raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, Eph 2:6
      - c. Hidden with Christ in God Col 3:3
  - C. Position Unknown
    - 1. Serves out of Gratitude, not sufficient for the difficulties one faces from his enemies.
    - 2. Serves with a better understanding of position in Christ, results in failure due to the self-effort to live according to those truths.
    - 3. Romans doesn't reveal concepts of growth until the concepts of righteousness is settled Ro 5:11, 17-18
      - a. Ro 1:1-5:11 presents the remedy for the penalty of sins, the blood secures forgiveness.
      - b. Ro 6-8 presents the remedy for the power of sin, the cross secures deliverance. Jo 10:10
  - D. Position Appreciated
    - 1. The Process of being made aware of self's bankruptcy. Ro 7:15-25

- a. The Savior dealt with symptoms and the disease the root and the fruit.
- b. A substitute for our sins, Identification with His death for our sinful self
- 2. God uses people and circumstances as trials to reveal to us the bankruptcy of the self-life.
- 3. When the self-life is revealed, then the believer is open to the truths of the Christlife.
  - a. The Holy Spirit determines when a person understands and is ready for the next step.
  - b. Even when one understands, they take their lifetime to learn how it applies in everyday life.
- E. Position Accepted
  - 1. Through the work of Christ, God sees us as
    - a. accepted in Christ Eph 1:6
    - b. complete in Christ Col 2:9
  - 2. When we abide in (remain) (reckon to be true) the positional truths, Eph 2:6; Col 3:1-3, we find. . .
    - a. Rest Mt 11:29; Heb 4:1,3,9-11
    - b. Fellowship Jo 17:21; 1 Co 1:9; 1 Jo 1:3
    - c. Growth Eph 4:15; 1 Pe 2:2; 2 Pe 3:18
