- 1. Have You Ever Had:
 - One Of Those "Mountain Top" Experiences:
 - In Your Life?
 - When It Seemed As If:
 - You Were At The Peak:
 - Of Satisfaction And Joy?
 - I Remember Having That Kind Of Feeling:
 - When Our Children Were Born:
 - And I Got To Hold Them In My Arms:
 - For The Very First Time!
 - But Like Most Of Those:
 - "Mountain Top" Experiences:
 - It Didn't Last Very Long!
 - Because Then The Valley Came:
 - When I Started To Think About And Feel:
 - The Heavy Responsibility That Comes Along:
 - With Having Those Bundles Of Joy!
- 2. Well As We've Been Making Our Way:
 - Through Paul's Letter To The Romans:
 - On Sunday Mornings:
 - We Came To One Of Those Spiritual:
 - Mountain Tops At The End Of Chapter 8
 - Where The Apostle Paul:
 - Invites Us To Rejoice In The Fact That As Believers In Christ:
 - There Is 8:38-39 Nothing:
 - "Neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, / Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord!"
 - Now That's A Mountain Top Feeling!
 - Of God's Love, God's Joy, God's Peace, And God's Hope!
 - It's A Place Of Feeling:
 - That You Never Want To Leave!
- 3. But From The Heights Of Glory:
 - There In Chapter 8 We Now Move On:
 - To Chapter 9 Where It Seems Like:
 - Paul Is Back In A Valley:
 - A Valley Of Deep Grief!
 - Even As He Says In:
 - 9:2 "I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart!"
 - And The Question Comes To Mind:
 - What Would Cause This Abrupt Change:
 - In The Heart Of Paul?
 - From Joy To Sorrow:
 - And From Glory To Grief?
- 4. Well As We Will See From:
 - 9:1-5 This Morning:
 - It Was Because There Were So Many:
 - Of His Own Country:
 - Who Did Not Know The Love Of God:
 - The Way He Did:
 - In Jesus Christ!
 - Instead So Many Of His Brethren:
 - Of His Own Nationality:
 - Continued To Reject The Love Of God:

- Which Was So Profoundly Demonstrated: - In The Coming Of Jesus Christ, Their Messiah! - So - Even As The Apostle Paul: - Celebrated: - The Grace Of God That: - Brought *Him* To Christ! - At The Same Time - He: - Lamented: - That The Vast Majority Of: - His Own People: - Continued To Resist The Blessings Of The Gospel! - And So - He Writes: - 9:1-5 - "I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost, / 2 That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart. / 3 For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh: / 4 Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises; / 5 Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen!" What We Find In These Verses Is That: - The Apostle Paul: - Experienced Some Of The Greatest Sorrow In His Heart: - Because Those He Loved: - Failed To Respond To: - The Love Of God! - And - Truly: - This Ought To Cause In Us - The Same Kind Of: - Sorrow - Even As We Rejoice: - In What God Has Done For Us! - Because - As We See From: - 9:1-3 - Unbelievers Fail To Respond To: The Great Pangs Of God's Love! - Sometimes We Forget That: - In Love - There Can Also Be: - Pain - And This Is What Paul Experienced: - In His Relationship With His Own People: - The Jews! - And - What He Is About To Say: - About His Sorrow: - Is So Shocking That: - He Needs To - In 9:1: - Tell Us Of: - The Reality Of His Pain! - 9:1 - "I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost!" - Paul Wanted Us To Know That: - He Was Being Completely Transparent! - He Was Baring His Heart And Soul To Us All: - And Telling Us The Truth! And: - His Heart-Felt Pain For His People: - Was Very Sincere!

- In Two Different Ways:

- He Was Speaking The Truth:

- "I Say The Truth" & "I Lie Not!"
- But - Even More:

- Was Spiritual At Its Core!

- His Heart-Felt Pain:

- He Testifies To The Truth: - Of His Feelings!

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- "In Christ!"
- And His "Conscience Also [Was] Bearing [Him] Witness":
 - "In The Holy Ghost!"
- It Was His Relationship With Jesus Christ:
 - That Caused Him:
 - To Feel The Same Pangs:
 - As Jesus Did:
 - When He Lamented Over The Plight Of His People!
 - Remember In The Gospels When Jesus Cried:
 - "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!" (Matthew 23:37; Luke 13:34)
- The Pain & Pangs Of Paul:
 - Was Like Christ's And:
 - It Was Real And Intense And So:
 - In 9:2 He Goes On To Give Us:
- The Report Of His Pain!
 - 9:2 "That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart!"
 - Here Paul Heaps Words Together:
 - To Try To Describe:
 - The Depth Of Sorrow He Has:
 - For His People!
 - He Is Full Of "Heaviness":
 - And Grief! And It Is:
 - An Internal Grief!
 - This Word Describes A Grief:
 - That Is So Deep That:
 - You Might Feel As If You Are Going To Be "Swallowed Up With Overmuch Sorrow!" (2 Cor. 2:7)
 - But It Was Also:
 - An Intense Grief!
 - It Is A "Great Heaviness" That Paul Bears!
 - It Is Strong And Powerful:
 - And A Deep, Deep Grief!
 - **IE:** The Kind Of Grief Of Losing A Loved One!
 - It Was Also:
 - An Incessant Grief!
 - "Continual" Paul Writes!
 - It Stayed In His Heart!
 - So Along With His Celebration Of Christ, There Was Still Lamentation In His Soul!
 - And It Was Also:
 - An Inconsolable Grief!
 - It Was A "Sorrow" That Felt Like:
 - The Sun Had Set Never To Rise Again:
 - On The Hearts Of His People!
 - This Great Grief & Pain:
 - Was A Reflection:
 - Of Paul's Great Love For His People!
 - But What Would Cause Him To Feel This Way?
 - Even After All He Said In Chapter 8?
 - In 9:3 We See:

- The Reason For His Pain!
 - 9:3 "For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh!"
 - Oh, How Paul Cared For His People!
 - Here He Gives One Of The Most Shocking Statements In All Of Scripture!

- "For I Could Wish That Myself Were Accursed From Christ For My Brethren!"
- Paul's Heart Yearned For His People:
 - To The Point That:
 - If It Were Possible & If It Were Permitted:
 - He Would Take The Eternal Punishment Of His People:
 - Upon Himself If Only They Might Believe In & Receive Christ!
- This Was The Same Kind Of Heart:
 - That Old Moses Had:
 - In Exodus 30:31-33 When He Prayed To The Lord "Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. / Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin —; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written!"
 - But How Did The Lord Respond?
 - "And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book!"
- This Was The Same Kind Of Heart:
 - That King David Had:
 - In 2 Samuel 18:33 For His Son "And the king was much moved, and went up to the chamber over the gate, and wept: and as he went, thus he said, O my son Absalom, my son, my son Absalom! would God I had died for thee, O Absalom, my son, my son!"
- But David & Moses & Paul Knew:
 - That They Could Not:
 - Be The Substitute That Their People Needed!
 - But They Had Such A Burden For The Souls Of Their People That They Were Willing To Be!
- But Jesus Christ Did Come:
 - To Be Their Substitute:
 - And To Bear The Curse:
 - That They & We Were Under!
 - Isaiah 53:4-5 "Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. / But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he was] bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace [was] upon him; and with his stripes we are healed!"
 - If Only Those We Love:
 - Would Know The Love Of God:
 - As We Do!
- And That Was One Of The Main Reasons:
 - For The Great Pain & Grief:
 - In Paul's Heart!
 - He Loved:
 - His "Brethren!"
 - He Was Moved For:
 - His "Kinsmen According To The Flesh!"
 - And Yet How Did They Respond:
 - To The Pangs Of His Love & Of Christ's Love?
 - They Continued To Resist & Reject:
 - And That Broke Paul's Heart!
 - But What About You & Me?
 - Do We Have This Kind Of Love:
 - For The Lost In Our Lives?
 - What Pain & Pangs:
 - Do We Have:
 - For Their Salvation?
 - Or If You Are Not A Christian:
 - Think About The Great Pain & Pangs:
 - Of Those Who Love You:
 - And Care For Your Soul!
 - Think About:

- The Heart Of:
 - Your Godly Parents, Pastor, And Friends!
- But Mostly How Will You Respond To:
 - The Heart Of Jesus Christ:
 - Who Died For You!
 - What Paul & Moses & David:
 - Wished They Could Do:
 - Jesus Did!
- Do Not Neglect:
 - The Pangs Of God's Love:
 - For You!
 - But Paul Was Also Concerned Because His People Failed To Respond To:

2. The Great Privileges Of God's Love!

- Which We Find Listed For Us:
 - In 9:4-5 "Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises; / Whose are the fathers!"
 - Paul Uses The Term "Israelites" On Purpose:
 - Because It Would Have Reminded His People:
 - Of Their Special Connection:
 - With God!
 - After All It Was God Himself:
 - Who Gave Jacob This Name:
 - "Prince Of God!"
 - And So All Of His Descendants Experienced:
- The Privilege Of:
 - God's Choice!
 - They Were "Adopted" By God:
 - As His Chosen People!
 - Deuteronomy 7:7-8 "The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye [were] the fewest of all people: / But because the LORD loved you!"
 - But What Had They Done:
 - With Their Privilege! Also:
- The Privilege Of:
 - God's Communion!
 - "And The Glory!" (9:4)
 - The Glory Of God Was The Physical Manifestation Of God:
 - And His Presence!
 - And The Glory Of God:
 - Was Manifested To Israel:
 - All Throughout Their History!
 - In The Wilderness:
 - Through The Cloud By Day & The Pillar Of Fire By Night!
 - In The Mountain!
 - In The Tabernacle & Temple:
 - Where God's Glory Filled The House!
 - This Showed Them That God Was With Them!
 - But What Did They Do:
 - With That Privilege? Also:
- The Privilege Of:
 - God's Compact!
 - "And The Covenants!" (9:4)
 - Which Were Special Promises Made:
 - To Their Fathers:
 - Abraham & Isaac & Jacob & Then Moses & David & Even Christ!
 - All Of These Compacts:
 - Were Compacts Of Blessing:
 - As We're Told In Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you,

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saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end!"
                 - But - How Did They Respond To:
                         - This Privilege? Also:
- The Privilege Of:
        - God's Commands!
                 - "And The Giving Of The Law!" (9:4)
                          - Which Are "Holy & Just & Good!"
        - It Is What God Used:
                 - To Form Them Into A Nation - But Also:
                         - To Reveal Himself & His Nature:
                                  - To Them!
        - And That Was A Great Privilege!
                 - As Moses Said In Deuteronomy 4:7-8 - "For what nation [is there so] great, who [hath] God [so]
                 nigh unto them, as the LORD our God [is] in all [things that] we call upon him [for]? / And what
                 nation [is there so] great, that hath statutes and judgments [so] righteous as all this law, which I set
                 before you this day?"
                         - But - How Did They Respond:
                                  - To This Privilege? Also:
- The Privilege Of:
        - God's Celebration And Worship!
                 - "And The Service Of God!" (9:4)
                          - God Showed Them:
                                  - Through The Pattern Of The Tabernacle & The Temple:
                                           - What It Would Take To Worship & Serve Him!
        - But - As We See From The New Testament:
                 - All Of Those Forms:
                          - Pointed To The Lord Jesus Christ!
                                  - The High Priest!
                                  - The Bread Of Life!
                                  - The Lamb Of God Which Taketh Away The Sin Of The World!
        - If Only They Had Eyes To See!
                 - If Only They Had Ears To Hear!
                          - If Only They Had Hearts To Understand!
                                  - But - How Did They Respond?
                                           - Also:
- The Privilege Of:
        - God's Commitment!
                 - "And The Promises!" (9:4)
                          - I Think This Especially Refers To:
                                  - The Promises & Prophecies:
                                           - About Their Messiah!
        - Over & Over Again:
                 - They Were Promised About One To Come:
                          - Who Would Be Their:
                                  - Final Prophet, Perfect Priest, And Everlasting King!
        - But - Did They Believe?
                 - Some Did! Some Looked For Him!
                          - Like - In The Gospels:
                                  - The Magi / Simeon / Anna / And Others Who: "Looked For Redemption In
                                  Israel!" (Luke 2:38)
        - But - For The Most Part:
                 - They Did Not Respond - And:
                          - They Did Not Believe:
                                  - In Those "Exceeding Great And Precious Promises!" (2 Peter 1:4)
                                           - But - Even More:
- The Privilege Of:
        - God's Counselors! (9:5)
                 - "Whose Are The Fathers!"
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- Of Course He Could Be Referring To:
 - Abraham, Isaac, And Jacob:
 - The Patriarchs!
- But Did Not God Also Provide:
 - Other Spiritual Fathers To His People?
 - Time After Time?
- But With All Of These Privileges:
 - Added To The One Paul Mentioned Back In:
 - 3:2 "Unto them were committed the oracles of God!"
 - How Did They Respond?
 - Well Sadly In Many Ways:
 - The Same Way We Respond:
 - To The Spiritual Privileges We Have Been Given By The Lord!
 - Like The Privileges & Blessings:
 - Of Our Homes & Churches!
 - Of God's Word & The Gospel!
 - We Must Not Neglect:
 - The Privileges Of God's Love:
 - For Us!
 - But Then Paul Adds:
 - One More Privilege:
 - That Was Given To His People By God!
 - And That Is:

3. The Great Person Of God's Love!

- 9:5 "And of whom as concerning the flesh Christ [came], who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen!"
 - It Was Through Israel:
 - That Jesus Came!
 - And This Was The Greatest Privilege Of All! And:
- He Came In Great Humility!
 - It Was Through Israel:
 - That Jesus Christ Came:
 - "As Concerning / According To The Flesh!"
 - Reminds Us Of:
 - The Great Humility & Humiliation:
 - That Jesus Took Upon Himself:
 - To Save His People From Their Sins! (Matthew 1:21)
 - As We Are Told:
 - In Philippians 2:7-8 It Was Jesus:
 - Who "Made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: / And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross!"
 - And He Did This:
 - For Them & For Us!
 - But Also Paul Adds:
- He Came In Great Honor!
 - Because Jesus Did Not Just Come:
 - As A Mere Man He Came:
 - As The One 9:5 "Who Is Over All, God Blessed Forever! Amen!"
 - Here Paul Points To:
 - Not Just The Human Nature Of Christ:
 - But Also The Divine Nature Of Christ!
 - He Is "God" Who Is "Over All!"
 - This Means:
 - That One Of The Greatest Promises:
 - Given To Israel:
 - Was Also Fulfilled!
 - The Promise Of:

- Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel!"
 - Which As Matthew Later Tells Us "Being Interpreted Is, God With Us!" (Matthew 1:23)
- God Himself Came Into This World:
 - To Be With His People And:
 - To Save His People And The World:
 - From Their Sins!
 - "Whosoever Believeth In Him!" (John 3:16)
 - And That Was & Still Is:
 - The Greatest Privilege Of All!
 - But How Did They Respond?
- I Think Our Own Hearts Should Break:
 - As We Hear The Words Of John:
 - In John 1:10-11 "He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. / He came unto his own, and his own received him not!"

 - To Their Greatest Privilege & Gift:
 - Broke The Apostle Paul's Heart!
- 2. But What About Us Today?
 - What About You?
 - How Have You Responded:
 - To The Great Pangs & Privileges & Person:
 - Of God's Love:
 - Which He Has Given You?
 - Do Ignore:
 - The Loving Pleas:
 - Of Those God Has Put In Your Life:
 - To Trust In & Live For:
 - The Lord Jesus Christ?
 - Have You Forgotten:
 - The Great Privileges & Gifts:
 - That God Has Given You:
 - So That You Can Give All You Have For Him?
 - Or Do You Keep Resisting:
 - The Loving Call Of Jesus:
 - Matthew 11:28 "Come unto me, all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest!"
- 3. Do Not Neglect:
 - All That God Has Done For You:
 - To Call You To Himself!
 - Do Not "Neglect So Great Salvation!" (Hebrews 2;3)

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
