Acts 18:1 After this Paul left Athens and went to Corinth. 2 And he found a Jew named Aquila, a native of Pontus, recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla, because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to leave Rome. And he went to see them, 3 and because he was of the same trade he staved with them and worked, for thev were tentmakers by trade. 4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every Sabbath, and tried to persuade Jews and Greeks. 5 When Silas and Timothy arrived from Macedonia, Paul was occupied with the word, testifying to the Jews that the Christ was Jesus. 6 And when they opposed and reviled him, he shook out his garments and said to them, "Your blood be on your own heads! I am innocent. From now on I will go to the Gentiles." 7 And he left there and went to the house of a man named Titius Justus, a worshiper of God. His house was next door to the synagogue. 8 Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed in the Lord, together with his entire household. And many of the Corinthians hearing Paul believed and were baptized. (ESV)



Application Questions

- 1. Read **Colossians 4:7-18**. What do you observe about Paul and his personal relationships from reading and pondering this closing section of his letter to the Colossian church?
- 2. Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 and Proverbs 27:17. In what ways do good, solid, godly Christian friends help you live the Christian life?
- 3. Read **Psalm 1:1**; **Proverbs 13:20** and **1 Corinthians 15:33**. How would you counsel a Christian who knows his companions are pulling him away from his devotion to Christ, but it would be hard to back out of the friendships?
- 4. Read **Matthew 5:13-16** and **Ephesians 5:11-14**. What steps can you take to make sure your actions and words are doing a better job of pointing people to Christ and ensuring you are not a neutral effect on their souls?
- 5. Read **Luke 12:51-53**. As difficult as this reality is, why would you say it is important to consider the potential of Christ and your commitment to him coming between you and someone you now see as a close friend?
