“The Triumph and Glory of the Servant of the Lord”
Isaiah 53:10-12

God is supremely glorified and pleased in the Person and Work of our Lord Jesus Christ!

1. The Pleasure of God in Judging Sin

v. 10

(1) The completeness of the judgment

*“Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him;
He has put Him to grief.”*

(2) The perfection of the judgment

“When You make His soul an offering for sin”

- the “assault” – the guilt or trespass offering

(3) The paradox of the judgment

- Life out of death! *“He shall see His seed”*

- Eternal life! *“He shall prolong His days”*

- God’s will prospers in this! *“And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand”*

2. The Pleasure of God in Justifying the Ungodly

v. 11

(1) The pleasure of Jesus in justifying sinners

*“He shall see the labor of His soul
and be satisfied.”*

(2) The peace of Jesus in justifying sinners

-1- A perfect moment *“He shall see the labor of His soul ... He shall bear their iniquities.”*

-2- A perfect knowledge *“By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many.”*

-3- A perfect righteousness

3. The Pleasure of God in Pouring out His Grace

v. 12

(1) The Champion of Grace

*“Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great,
And He shall divide the spoil with the strong.”*

(2) The Recipients of Grace

- “the great” “the strong”

- A.K.A. “the transgressors”!¹

(3) The Work of Grace: all of Christ!

*“Because He poured out His soul unto death,
And He was numbered with the transgressors,
And He bore the sin of many,
And made intercession for the transgressors.”*
