 - "Evangelist had directed Christian to Christ; he had not told him to get rid of his burden, but to go to Christ, and Christ would remove it in good time!"
- But At This Point, Christian Was Ready To Try Anything:
 - To Get Relief From The Burden Of His Guilt!
 - And So Mr. Worldly-Wiseman:
 - Also Seemed To Offer:

2. A Better Path For Christian!

- This Gentleman Seemed To Know:
 - Quite A Bit About This Path:
 - That Christian Was On!
 - Perhaps Because, At One Time:
 - He Too Had Started Down That Narrow Path!
- But Like Pliable:
 - It Turned Out To Be More Difficult:
 - Than He Wanted It To Be!
 - So, He Too, Turned Out Of The Way!
 - He Didn't Go:
 - All The Way Back:
 - Like Pliable!
 - Because There Were Some Things He Liked:
 - About That Path!
 - Perhaps He Liked:
 - Some Of The Respectable:
 - People He Met! Or:
 - Some Of The Clean & Civil:
 - Places He Went!
- So Instead Of Going All The Way Back:
 - To The City Of Destruction:
 - Which May Have Been More Like:
 - Sodom & Gomorrah!
 - He Found His Way To:
 - The Town Of "Carnal Policy!"
 - A Place That Was:
 - Far More Sophisticated And Civil!
 - But It Was Still:
 - On The Outside:
 - Of The Wicket-Gate!
- And So To Follow The Path Christian Was On:
 - Was Far Too Dangerous & Inconvenient For Mr. Worldly-Wiseman!
 - He Described It As A Way:
 - Of "Wearisomeness, Painfulness, Hunger, Perils, Nakedness, Sword, Lions, Dragons, Darkness, And, In A Word, Death, And What Not!"
 - Its Almost As If He Was Quoting:
 - The Apostle Paul About:
 - The Dangers He Faced In His Life & Service For Christ!
 - But He Forgot The Most Important Part Of That Path Didn't He!
 - Because In Romans 8:35 Paul Asks "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?" And He Answers 8:37-39 "Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. / For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, / Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord!"

- But The Path That Leads Through The Love Of Christ:
 - Is Truly The Safest Path Of All!
- But Christian Didn't Fully Realize That Yet!
 - So His New Friend:
 - Seemed To Also Offer:

3. A Better Peace For Christian!

- Even A Quick & Easy Peace!
 - He Told Christian:
 - "The Remedy Is At Hand!"
- Isn't This What:
 - Anyone With Any Kind Of Sickness:
 - Loves To Hear!
 - "The Remedy Is At Hand!"
- I'm Sure This Is What:
 - That Woman Who Had The Issue Of Blood For 12 Years Thought:
 - In Mark 5 When 5:26 She "Had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse!"
 - But The Doctors Kept Telling Her:
 - "The Remedy Is At Hand!"
 - "The Remedy Is At Hand!"
 - Try This Medicine! Try This Essential Oil! Try This Therapy! Try This! Try This! Try This!
 - And After Years Of Her Life:
 - Disappeared As Quickly As:
 - Her Money She:
 - "Was Nothing Bettered!"
- Jesus Tells Us Where True Peace Lies:
 - In John 14:27 He Said:
 - "Peace *I* leave with you, *my* peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid!"
 - When That Woman With The Issue Of Blood:
 - Touched The Garment Of Jesus:
 - She Knew That:
 - Her "Remedy" Was Then "At Hand!"
 - So It Would Be For Christian!
 - And So It Will Be:
 - For Anyone Who Seeks To Touch Jesus & Trust In Jesus:
 - As That Woman Did!
- But Christian Was Not Quite Ready:
 - For That So:
 - Mr. Worldly-Wiseman Also Seemed To Offer:

4. A Better Provision For Christian!

- Even Inexpensive And Cheap!
 - He Told Christian About:
 - The Town Of "Morality!"
 - And How "There Are Houses Now Stand Empty, One Of Which Thou Mayest Have At Reasonable Rates; Provision Is There Also Cheap And Good!"
- And That Was Appealing:
 - To Our Poor Pilgrim:
 - Who Was Also:
 - Tired & Lonely & Ragged!
 - But Even Though At Times:
 - You May Get A True Bargain!
 - Most Of The Time:
 - The Old Adage Is True:
 - "You Get What You Pay For!"

- Because When It Comes To Spiritual Things:
 - The Best Things:
 - Come At The:
 - Highest Cost!
 - Though Eternal Life:
 - Is A Free Gift:
 - To Those Who Believe:
 - In Christ!
 - Yet Even That Freedom:
 - Was Not Free!
 - Because As Peter Tells Us:
 - In 1 Peter 1:18-19 "Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; / But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot!"
 - There Is No Higher Cost:
 - That Could Have Been Paid:
 - For The Cleansing & Saving:
 - Of Christian's Soul:
 - Than The Blood Of Christ!

- But To Turn Aside:
 - To A Place Where Rates:
 - Seemed More "Reasonable":
 - Would Eventually Cost Him:
 - His Own Life Besides!
- But Perhaps One Other Question:
 - Should Have Come To His Mind:
 - Before Christian Made Up His Mind:
 - To Take Mr. Worldly-Wiseman's Advice!
 - Why Where There So Many Houses:
 - Standing "Empty" In That Village Of Morality?
 - Why Was The Supply There:
 - So Much Greater Than The Demand?
- The Provision Seemed So Much Better!
 - But If The Location Of That Village:
 - Was Built On Top Of An Old Toxic Landfill:
 - How Many Citizens Would Have Gotten Sick & Died All Because:
 - The "Rates" Were "Reasonable!"
- But At This Point:
 - Christian Was Still Blind To All Of This!
 - So It All Seemed To Him:
 - To Be So Much Better:
 - Than The Path He Was On!
 - And So Mr. Worldly-Wiseman:
 - Tried To Show Christian:
 - That His Way Offered:
- 5. A Better Promise For Christian!
 - The Wisdom Of This World:
 - Wants You To Think:
 - That The "Here And Now" Is:
 - Far Better Than:
 - The "There And Later!"

- The Advice:
 - That Evangelist Gave To Christian:
 - Was Ridiculed By:
 - Mr. Worldly-Wiseman!
 - He Told Christian:
 - That His Book Caused Him To:

- "Run" "Desperate Ventures, To Obtain They Know Not What!"
- But His Advice:
 - Would Bring To Christian:
 - "Much Safety, Friendship, And Content!"
 - And Even More:
 - It Would Reunite Him:
 - To His Beloved Family!
 - "Thou Mayest Send For Thy Wife And Children To Thee To This Village" Of Morality!
- So The Wisdom Of This Age:
 - Wants You To Think:
 - That What You Can See & Feel:
 - Is What Is Best!
 - But What Does:
 - The Apostle Paul Remind Us:
 - As Christian Pilgrims?
 - 2 Corinthians 4:18 "While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.
- But The "Here And Now" Is:
 - So Appealing & So Compelling Isn't It?
 - Well It Was For Christian!
 - And So As We Will Begin Reading Next Week:
 - "Christian Turned Out Of His Way!"

 - A Great Antipathy!
 - When Mr. Worldly-Wiseman:
 - Is Confronted By The Things Of God:
 - And True Wisdom:
 - He Shows His True Colors & His Disdain:
 - First:

- For God's Ministers!
 - When Mr. Worldly-Wiseman Heard That:
 - Christian Had Met Evangelist:
 - Remember How He Reacted?
 - In A Visceral Way He Said:
 - "I Beshrew Him For His Counsel! There Is Not A More Dangerous And Troublesome Way In The World That Is That Unto Which He Hath Directed Thee!"
 - Seems Like Christian:
 - Touched A Nerve!
 - Seems Like Mr. Worldly-Wisemen:
 - Either Knew Or Had Met Evangelist Sometime Before!
 - And With His Bitterness:
 - He Was Betraying The Very Source:
 - Of His Wisdom & Advice!
 - As James Tells Us In James 3:14-15 "But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. / This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish!"
 - He Also Showed His Disdain:
- For God's Message!
 - When Mr. Worldly-Wiseman Asked Christian:
 - "How Camest Thou By The Burden At First?"
 - Christian Answered:
 - "By Reading This Book In My Hand!"
 - Again His Reaction Is Telling!
 - "I Thought So" He Said!
 - And Then He Tells Christian What He Things About That Book!
 - He Thinks That:
 - It Is Full Of:
 - "Things Too High" For Men Like Christian!
 - He Thinks That:
 - It Is Full Of:
 - "Distractions" That "Unman Men" And Cause Them To Run "Upon Desperate Ventures!"
 - He Doesn't Think:
 - Too Highly Of:
 - That Book In Christians Hand:
 - Does He?
 - But I Think We Also Hear In These Words:
 - What He & What The World:
 - Really Thinks And Feels:
- For God's Moving!
 - Like He Was Doing In The Heart Of That Pilgrim!
 - He Seemed So Polished & Polite:
 - To That Ragged Sinner:

- But What Did He Really:
 - Think About Him?
- Mr. Worldly-Wiseman Lumped Him Together:
 - With "Other Weak Men" Who:
 - Were Enamored With That Book!
 - And Considered Him A Simpleton:
 - Who Was "Meddling With Things Too High" For Someone Like Him!
 - He Also Not So Subtly:
 - Called Him "Crazed In [His] Wits" Because Of His Burden!
- This Is What The "Wisdom Of This World" Really Thinks:
 - About God's:
 - Ministers, Message, And Moving!
 - Its All A Bunch Of:
 - Foolishness!
 - They Will Say:
 - When Confronted By The Truth:
 - You Are A Fool!
 - A Fool:
 - To Believe What You Believe!
 - In A Book Filled With Fairy-Tales?
 - Creation? Sin? Flood? Jesus?
 - To Live Like You Live!
 - A Life Of Sacrifice!
 - Sundays? Weekends?
 - To Think As You Think!
 - That Your Reward Is In Heaven!
 - But What Does Our Book Say?
 - 1 Corinthians 1:25-29 "Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. / For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: / But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; / And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: / That no flesh should glory in his presence!"

 - Though What It Offers You:
 - Seems So Appealing!
 - Remember That It Is:
 - Antagonistic:
 - To The Wisdom Of God!
 - And That Is Why We Also Need To See That:
- 3. There's A Great Alarm:
 - From The Wisdom Of This World!
 - A Great Alarm!
 - What Are The Warning Signs:
 - Of This World's Wisdom?
 - What Should Christian As Well As We Be Looking Out For?
 - Watch Out For:
 - The Comfort Of This World!
 - That Was All That Mr. Worldly-Wisemen:
 - Focused On With Christian!
 - Comfort!
 - A Comfortable Life!
 - With "Much Safety, Friendship, And Content!"
 - To Live A "Normal" Life:

- Like Everyone Else!
- Live The American Dream!
 - Work For The Weekends!
 - Get A Home In The Suburbs!
 - Retire At The Villages!
- Wasn't This The Goal Of The Rich Man:
 - In Jesus' Parable In Luke 12:19-20 "I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry!" / But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?"
- Remember:
 - 1 Corinthians 3:19 "The wisdom of this world is foolishness with God!"
