Everybody Dies

(Enjoying Life in the Shadow of Death)
Ecclesiastes 9:1-10

- I. <u>THE SHADOW OF DEATH</u> (2-3a, 5-6, 10b)
 - **A.** The Common Destiny (2-3)—the people of this world for death/the grave
 - 1. Certain and Unavoidable (Ezek 18:4; Rom 6:23; 1 Cor 15:21)
 - **2.** The Wicked and the Righteous (Ecc 7:20; 8:8,10; Rom 3:10, 23)
 - 3. An Evil Thing—seems unfair, something is not right
 - **B.** The Coming End (1 Cor 7:29, 31; 1 Jn 2:17)—the things of this world (under the sun)
 - 1. Of <u>Awareness</u> (5a, 6a)—thought and feeling
 - 2. Of Memory (5c) the memory of you; you will be forgotten
 - **3.** Of Reward (5b; Mat 6:2, 5, 16)—if you have labored *only for the things of this life*, all that is over and done with.
 - **4. Of <u>Action</u>** (10b)
 - a. Your <u>participation</u> in the business and affairs of this life—ability to plan and do things
 - **b. Your** ability to make changes—repent, change course, make amends, do good
- **II.** THE HAND OF GOD (1)—He's holding the reins.
 - **A.** <u>God's Sovereign Will</u> (Pro 20:24; Is 45:7)—authority; His purpose, choice, plan, and the power to make it happen
 - 1. <u>God is in control</u>. (Implication: We are <u>not</u>).
 - 2. We can't know what is coming (Implication: God does).

- **B.** God's Good Providence (Ps 57:2; 138:8)—management; carrying out His purpose and plan for our lives
 - 1. Actively Directing all things that come to us
 - **2.** <u>Personally Involved</u> (Ps 1:6; Rom 8:28)—has a unique and intimate relationship with the righteous
- **III.** THE HEARTS OF MEN (3b; 6:10; 7:29)—the heart of the problem is the human heart
 - A. <u>Evil</u> (4:1-8)—immoral, unjust
 - B. <u>Madness</u>—foolishness; naturally don't know what's good for us
- IV. THE LIFE BEFORE DEATH (4-10)—it is not meaningless
 - **A.** <u>Time to Change</u> (2 Cor 6:2; Heb 9:27)
 - **B.** Things to Enjoy(7-9)—earthly blessings
 - **1. Feasting** (7)
 - 2. Dressing Up (8)
 - **3. Marriage** (9; Gen 2:18; Mat 22:30)
 - **D.** Work to Be Done (10; Jn 4:34; 9:4; 1 Cor 15:58; Col 1:29; 3:23-24; Rev 14:13)
 - 1. We can make a difference here and now.
 - 2. We will be rewarded by Jesus.
 - 3. Our good works will follow us.
